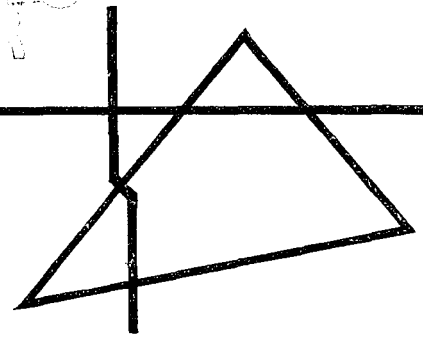

Policy for University of Hawaii Relations in the Pacific

The 1970-71 academic year opens with a new dimension on University interest in Oceania. President Cleveland has requested the Advisory Council on the International Relations of the University to provide him with basic information and policy recommendations on the U.H.'s relations with American Samoa, Micronesia, and with the University of the South Pacific. A Pacific Committee of the Council will prepare background statements and policy suggestions for full Council deliberation. Fundamental to the request are the existence of U.H. contracts with the first two named areas (as in education, public health, etc.) and the President's institutional tie with the U.S.P. through his seat on its council.

Meeting on American Samoa

To all members of the University community interested in U.H.-American Samoa relations: please mark the afternoon of Wednesday, Sept. 23rd, on your calendar. Representatives of University agencies having contracts for research, training, or other service in American Samoa, as well as persons in any way interested in U.H.-American Samoa relations, are requested to attend the meeting at 3:30 o'clock in Room 226 of George Hall. Information will be sought on on-going or contemplated commitments in American Samoa, and on activities at the U.H. which may have an effect thereon. Also, everyone interested is solicited to express his opinion on what ought be University policy with regard to U.H.-American Samoa relationships. A task force of Fern Ihara (ch.), Horace Lay, and Richard Suchiro will draft a proposed background and policy statement for Pacific Committee consideration, incorporating the pertinent data and opinions presented at the September 23rd meeting.

Meeting on Micronesia

A general meeting of the University community interested in Micronesia, comparable to that scheduled for American Samoa, will be held in mid-October, on a date yet to be fixed. You will be alerted in the next NEWSLETTER.
