

Relative to your prior request for additional data required under the referenced Project, we have forwarded under separate cover, on a tube, the 11 white sheet maps of Ponape at scale of 1:10000, together with their corresponding mylar over-lays whereupon, the positioning and spellings of over 1,300 place names are indicated.

For all practical and other purposes, you are herein advised that the submitted data are results of a lengthy processes undertaken by a "SPECIAL TASK FORCE" duly appointed by the Governor and assisted by numerous knowledgeable people from each of the six municipalities of Ponape, together with selected members of the Governor's staff. The SPECIAL TASK FORCE itself consist of the Historic Preservation Officer as Chairman; the Language Specialist of the Department of Education as a member; the Land Management Officer as member, and Pensile Lawrence as member.

With regards to your additional requested requirement along the area of translating the meanings of each place names, this have had to be deleted until such time that funding can be available. Where the task requires soliciting assistance from non-government employees for a period of at least three additional months, we felt its only proper that we pay per diem of \$15.00 per person per day and with our budgetary constraint, we have no other alternative but to delete the translation at this time.
