History: The Church was established in 1978 by Rev. James Wong, at the current address, with the purpose of establishing a Chinese Christian witness and outreach program for the Chinese community in Hawaii. It was sponsored by the the Nuuanu Baptist Church.

Activities All services, meetings, and activities are conducted in Mandarin Chinese.

Sunday: 9:00 am—worship services; 11:00 am—Sunday school and children’s worship

Wednesday: 7:00 pm—prayer and Bible-study meeting

Thursday: 10 am—Evergreen Christian Youth Association meeting on the Thursday after the first Sunday of the month; 6 pm—Brothers meeting on the Thursday after the third Sunday of the month.

Friday: 7:30 pm—separate meetings for each of the following groups: High School Christian Youth Association; University of Hawaii Christian Youth Association; Professional Christian Association meeting

Saturday: 8:45 am—Choir practice; 3:30 pm—Sisters meetings in the second and fourth weeks

In addition, special events include lectures, celebratory meals, and programs broadcast via radio and television.

Membership: The Church has about 120 members. Weekly attendance at Sunday services (including members, family, friends, and occasional attendees) is regularly over 170 persons. Any born-again Christian who follows Biblical instruction, has been baptized by immersion, and promises to live according to Biblical teachings is welcome to be a member. There are no required dues or fees, but voluntary offerings are gratefully accepted.
