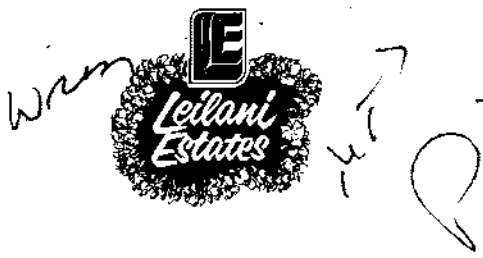

Dear Mr. Paty:

The Leilani Estates Community Association would like you to look into what appears to be a serious permit violation for the PGV power transmission line corridor along the edge of Leilani Estates. The forest was cut to a width of between 100 and 150 feet, including in many cases up to 50 feet of forest situated on private property, located within Leilani Estates subdivision. A road 50' wide was then bulldozed down the center of the cleared area and the power poles were installed. The residents at the annual Leilani Estates General Membership Meeting voted to ask for an investigation and if violations did occur or other laws broken, that appropriate action be taken. We look forward to your response.
