Notes on Summer Sessions

Shunzo Sakamaki . . . Dean of Summer Session

Summer Session began at the University of Hawaii in 1927, with 236 students. In 1964 the total enrollment was some 10,800 students, an increase of 15.6% over the 1963 figure of 9,385. The annual increase in recent years seems to maintain a ratio of 70% of the students being from Hawaii, 25% from other states, and 5% from other countries. To cope the tremendous burgeoning of the student population there has been a corresponding expansion of curriculum and faculty. The 1964 summer faculty included 85 visiting lecturers.
