As SB 2039-84, SB 1789-84 and SB 2246-84 would amend the present law regarding the use of nets and traps in fishing, HRS 188-29(a). This statement on these bills does not reflect an institutional position of the University of Hawaii.

SB 1789 would delete some language pertaining to dimensions of bullpen traps; SB 2246 however would revise the definitions. We do not consider that the definitions are very important. If they are needed they would be somewhat improved by SB 2246, but they are not really satisfactory even in that bill.
