On the agenda will be submission of a Pacific language-and-area-study proposal to H.E.W., a report on Pacific research prospects, and discussion of clearance procedures of Pacific-related contracts and grants.

"In addition to providing for the continuation of major on-going projects in the fields of Education, Public and Dental Health, Youth Education, Community Education Training, Agricultural and Fisheries development, the 1973 Budget approved seven new posts - Documentalist, Dietitian-Home Economist, Audio Visual Aids Planning Officer, Social Welfare Training Officer, Animal Production Officer, a second Fisheries Officer and a Plant Protection Officer. . . . In endorsing the South Pacific Conference recommendation concerning the holding of the 1973 13th Conference and 36th Session at Guam, the Commissioners agreed that a detailed comparative analysis for holding a Conference at Guam and Noumea should be prepared so that a valid assessment of Guam's offer to host the Conference/Session in 1973 could be made."
