PROCLAMATION
OF
FOREST RESERVE
IN THE
DISTRICT OF PUNA
ISLAND AND COUNTY OF HAWAII
TERRITORY OF HAWAII

UNDER and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the provisions of Chapter 47 of the Revised Laws of Hawaii 1925, and of every other power mehereunto enabling, I, W. R. Farrington, Governor of Hawai, with the approval of a majority of the Board of Commissioners of Agriculture and Forestry, having held the hearing of which notice has been duly given all as in said laws provided, do hereby recommend and approve as a forest reserve, to be called the NANAWALE FOREST RESERVE, portions of government and privately owned lands in the District of Puna, Island and County of Hawaii, Territory of Hawaii, containing a net total area of 5,703.92 acres, more or less, more particularly described by and on a map made by the Government Survey Department of the Territory of Hawaii, which said map is now on file in the said Survey Department marked "Nanawale Forest Reserve", and a description accompanying the same, numbered C.S.F. 4802, which said description now on file in said Survey Department is as follows:

NANAWALE FOREST RESERVE

Puna, Hawaii.

Including the land of Honolulu (Grant 3331 to Keaweopala); portions of the lands of Nanawale and Waawaa (part of Grant 2687 Apana 2 to Manamana); portion of the land of Kahuwai (L.C.A. 7713 Apana 12 R.P. 6884 to V. Kamamalu); portion of the land of Puua (L.C.A. 8452 Apana 15 R.P. 7788 to A. Keohokalole); and portions of the government lands of Nanawale, Waawaa, Halepuua, Kanekiki and Kanihiku.

C.S.T. 4802

Beginning at the seacoast on the Southeast edge of the Lava Flow of 1840, being the North angle of Grant 3687 to R.A. Lyman and on the boundary of said grant and the land of Nanawale, the approximate coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Trig. Station "Sand Hill" being 1800 feet South and 1800 feet East, and from Government Survey Trig. Station "Kapoho" being 18604 feet North and 9951 feet West, as shown on Government Survey Registered Map No. 2191, and running by true azimuths:-

1. 33° 00' 900.0 feet along Grant 3687 to R.A. Lyman, the Government Road and Grant 997 Apana 1 to Haole;
2. 57° 48' 4255.0 feet along Grant 3687 to R.A. Lyman and Grant 2687 Apana 2 to Manamana to the edge of the lava flow of 1840;
3. Thence following the Southeast edge of said lava flow, across Grant 2687 Apana 2 to Manamana, and the land of Kahuwai, L.C.A. 7713 Apana 12 (R.P. 6884) to V. Kamamalu, to the North boundary of the government land of Halepuua, the direct azimuth and distance being: 19° 00' 7500.0 feet;
4. 251° 38' 13500.0 feet along the government land of Halepuua to the West angle of Grant 998 to Kanelaeole;
5. 330° 00' 1131.0 feet along Grant 998 to Kanelaeole;
6. 251° 00' 427.0 feet along same to the Government Main Road;
7. 341° 00' 399.0 feet along the West side of the Government Main Road to Northeast corner of Grant 3000 to Kapoho;
8. 70° 00' 2165.0 feet along Grant 3000 to Kapoho, Paahana and Pio;

9. 334° 00' 661.0 feet along same to the North angle of Grant 1362 to Kaaiawaawa;
10. 69° 00' 3472.0 feet along Grant 1362 to Kaaiawaawa;
11. 10° 00' 1427.0 feet along same to the land of Puua, L.C.A. 8452 Apana 15 (R.P. 7788) to A. Keohokalole to a rock marked thus \square by an old road;

Thence following the North boundary of the land of Puua, along an old road, on the following direct azimuths and distances:-

12. 122° 00' 686.0 feet;
13. 103° 00' 990.0 feet;
14. 74° 00' 2666.0 feet;
15. 97° 00' 1175.0 feet;
16. 81° 00' 2858.0 feet;
17. 97° 00' 726.0 feet;
18. 69° 00' 752.0 feet to the edge of the Lava Flow of 1840;
19. Thence along the edge of the aa flow of 1840 to a pile of stones at "Omao" near the Imiwale belt of woods, being the Northeast corner of the land of Kaniahiku and the Northwest corner of the land of Halekamahina, the direct azimuth and distance being: 25° 53' 10278.0 feet;
20. 18° 30' 2802.0 feet along the land of Halekamahina to a pile of stones on the Puuohaua Ridge being the Northwest corner of the land of Kapoho;
21. 321° 30' 4864.0 feet along the land of Kapoho to the foot of Kiapu Hill, being the South angle of the land of Kaniahiku from which the Government Survey Trig. Station "Kiapu" bears 25° 24' 402.0 feet;
22. 122° 33' 4835.0 feet along the land of Keahialaka across the lava flow of Papalauahi to a large mound of stones from which the Government Survey Trig. Station "Puuohaua" bears: 205° 12' 1337.0 feet;
23. 95° 40' 4270.0 feet through the woods of Kamakana;
24. 171° 14' 341.0 feet to mound of stones at the South angle of Grant 3224 to Kekipi and La;
25. 118° 10' 457.0 feet along said grant to a mound of stones;
26. 145° 32' 761.0 feet along said grant to a mound of stones at West angle of grant;
27. 94° 20' 2490.0 feet along Keahialaka to the South angle of the Kaniahiku Tract;
28. Thence northerly along the edge of the aa flow of 1840 to the East corner of Lot 9, Kaniahiku Homesteads (Grant 6876 to K. Kaawa), the direct azimuth and distance being: 225° 31' 2892.0 feet;

29. Thence northerly along the edge of said flow across the lands of Puua and Kahuwai to the South boundary of the government land of Nanawale, the direct azimuth and distance being: 203° 08' 14656.0 feet;
30. 67° 00' 2746.0 feet along the land of Kahuwai;
31. 78° 00' 1078.0 feet along same;
32. 66° 00' 400.0 feet along same to "N" cut in pahoe-hoe at the junction of the lands of Waiakahiula, Nanawale and Kahuwai;
33. 214° 00' 1841.0 feet along the land of Waiakahiula, L.C.A. 11216 Apana 40 (R.P.8095) to kakauonohi to a + cut in rock;
34. 234° 00' 5188.0 feet along same to "K" cut in lava;
35. 225° 00' 2937.0 feet along same to pile of stones by a volcanic crack at head of the land of Honolulu;
36. 193° 00' 620.0 feet along the land of Waiakahiula, L.C.A. 11216 Apana 40 Part 1 (R.P.8095) to M. Kekauonohi;
37. 211° 00' 686.0 feet along same;
38. 192° 00' 660.0 feet along same;
39. 215° 00' 660.0 feet along same;
40. 223° 00' 486.0 feet along same;
41. 246° 00' 749.0 feet along same;
42. 236° 00' 645.0 feet along same;
43. 225° 00' 2495.0 feet along same;
44. 226° 00' 439.0 feet along same to the seashore;
45. Thence along the seashore to the point of beginning, the direct azimuth and distance being: 299° 22' 6426.0 feet to the point of beginning.

AREA 5812.0 ACRES

Excepting and reserving therefrom Grant 3226 to Kahuluna (Area 58.73 Acres) and Grant 3224 to Kekipi and La (Area 41.05 Acres), both situate in said forest reserve.

Also, excepting and reserving the right-of-way 40 feet wide for the Hawaii Consolidated Railway Company across said forest reserve, Area 8.3 acres, LEAVING A NET AREA OF 5703.92 ACRES.


