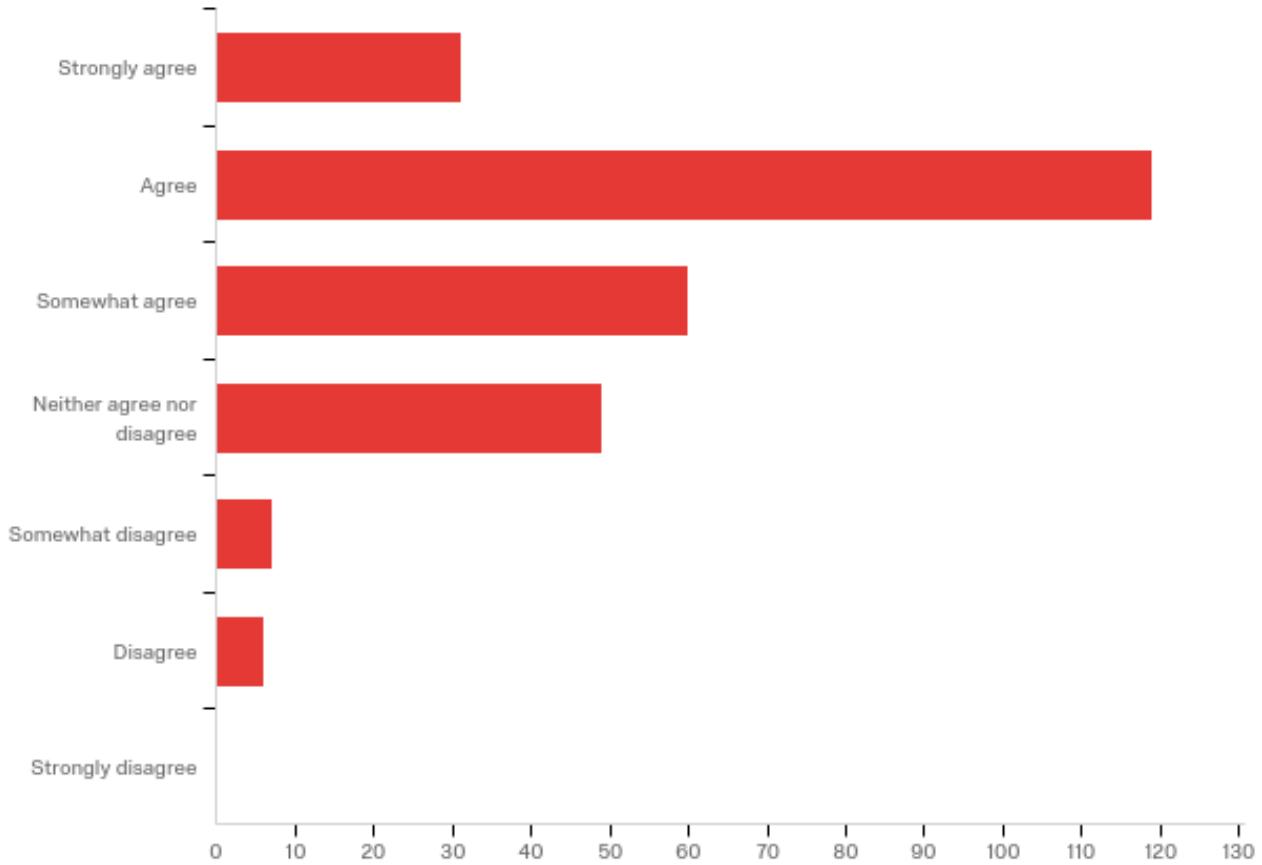

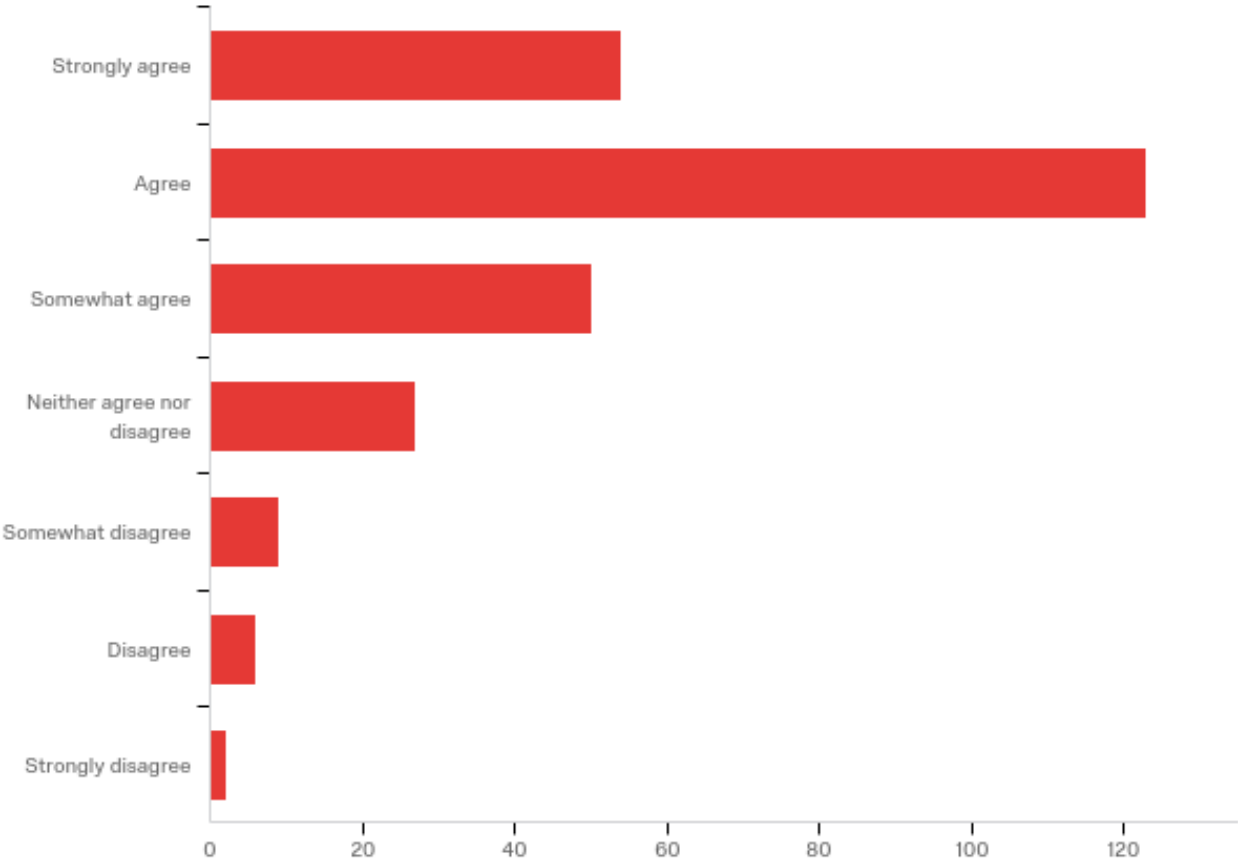

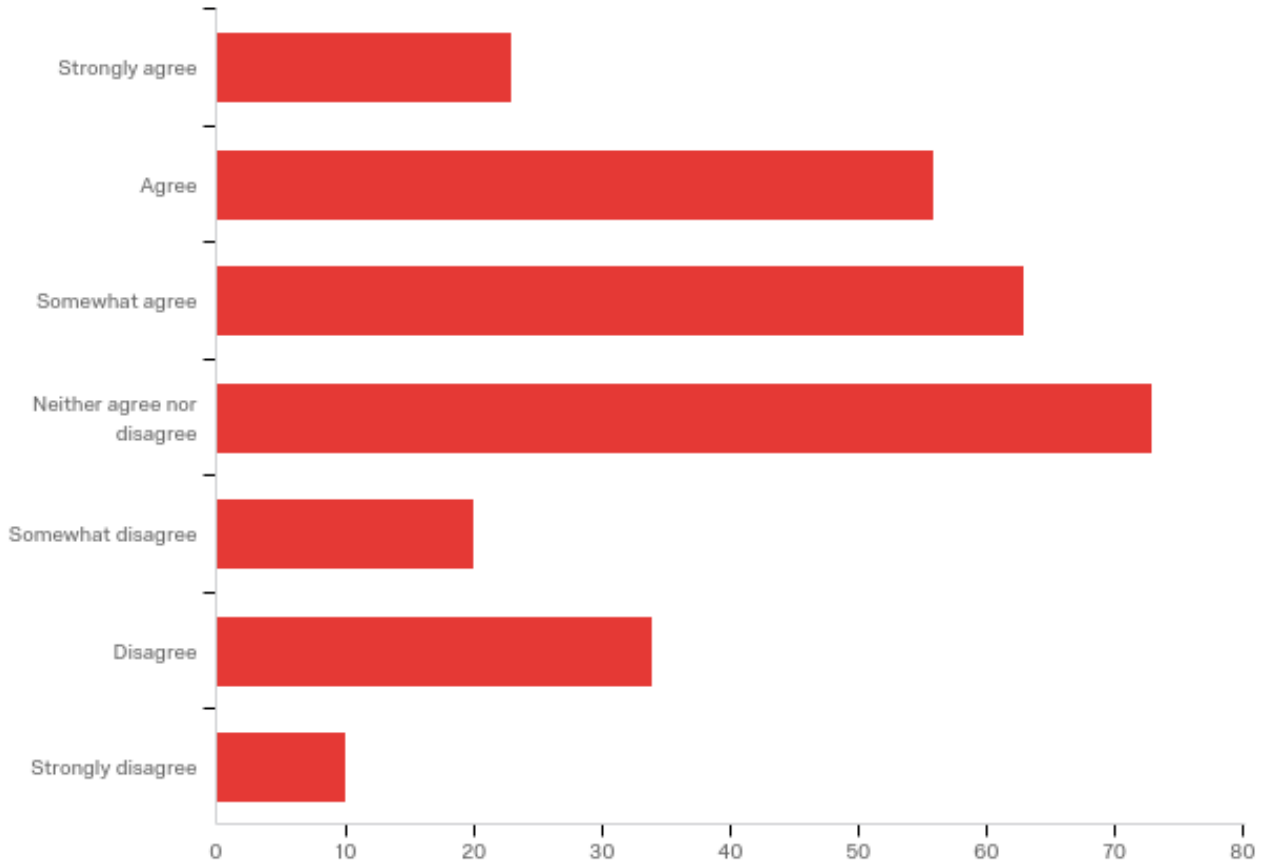

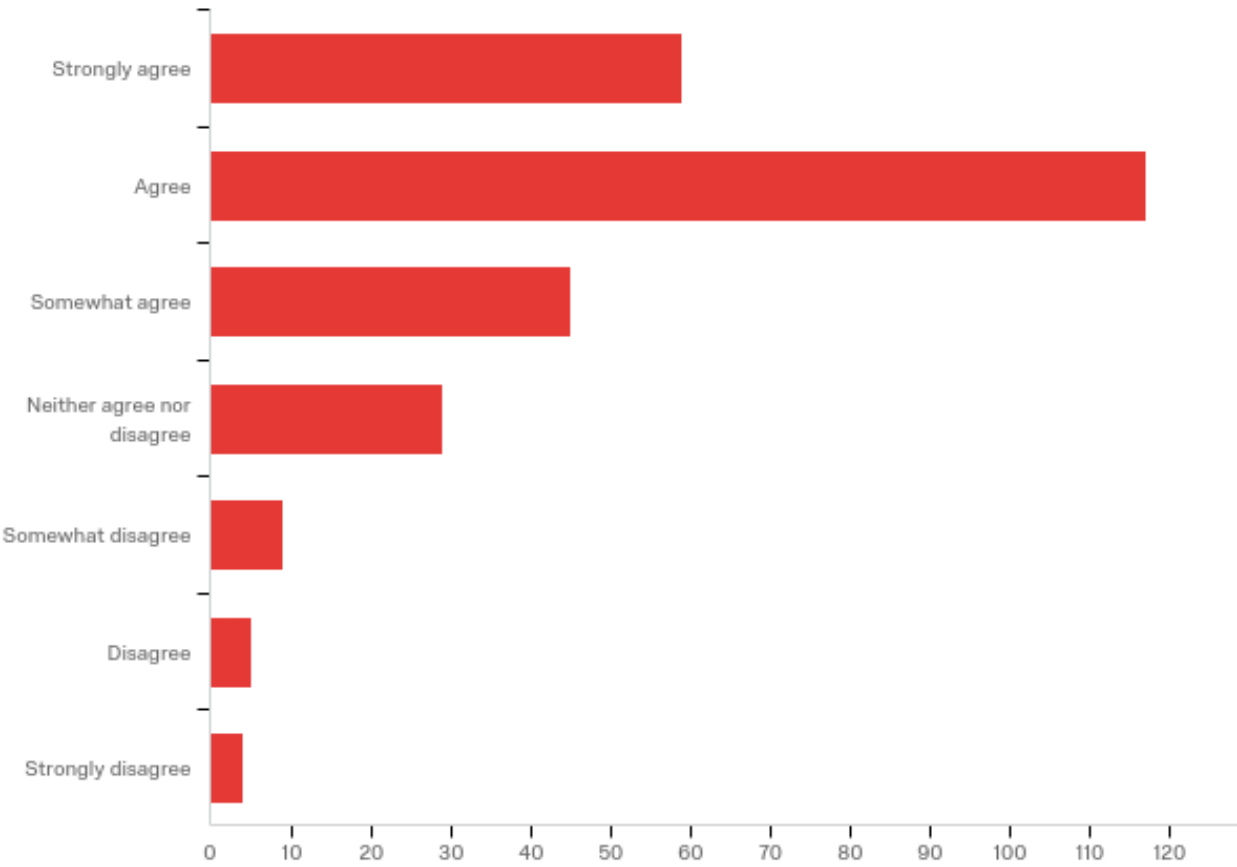

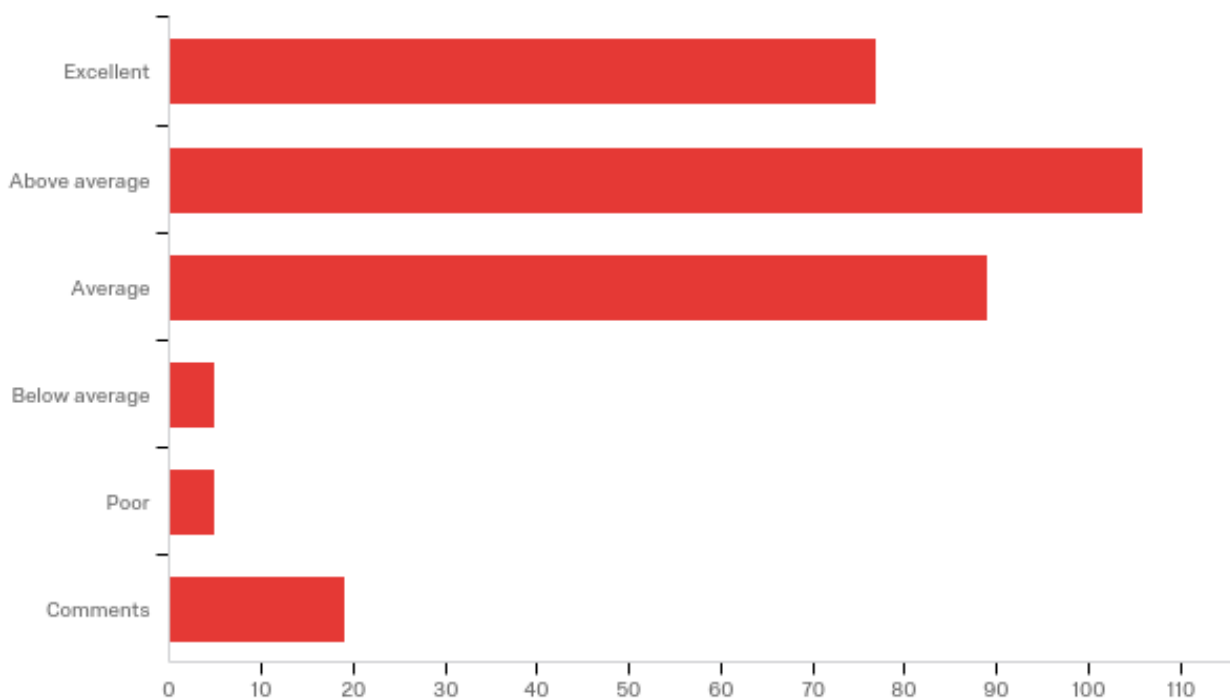

I rarely used the textbook. Information in class was well presented and if I had any questions, they were answered via communication with the professor, or searched on the web.

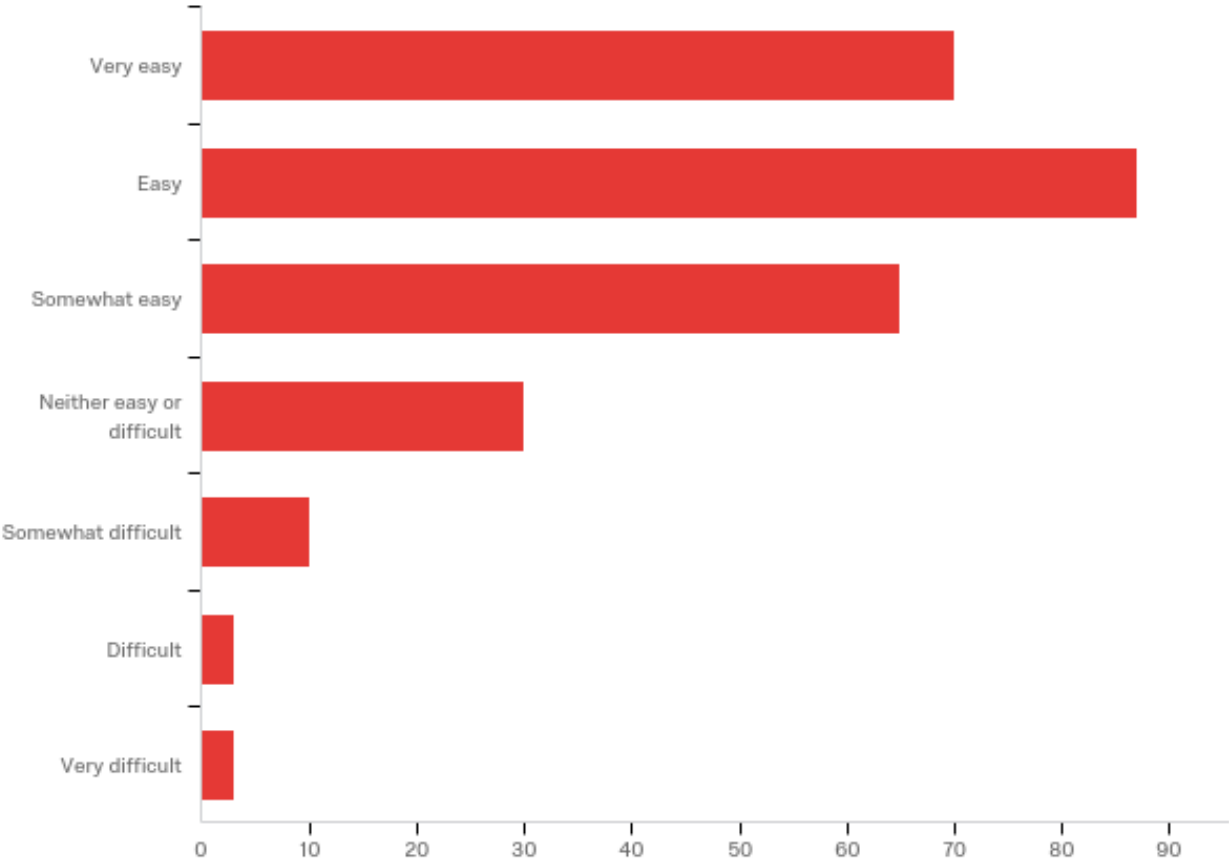
I love that the textbook was free and digital, I highly recommend this textbook continue to be used

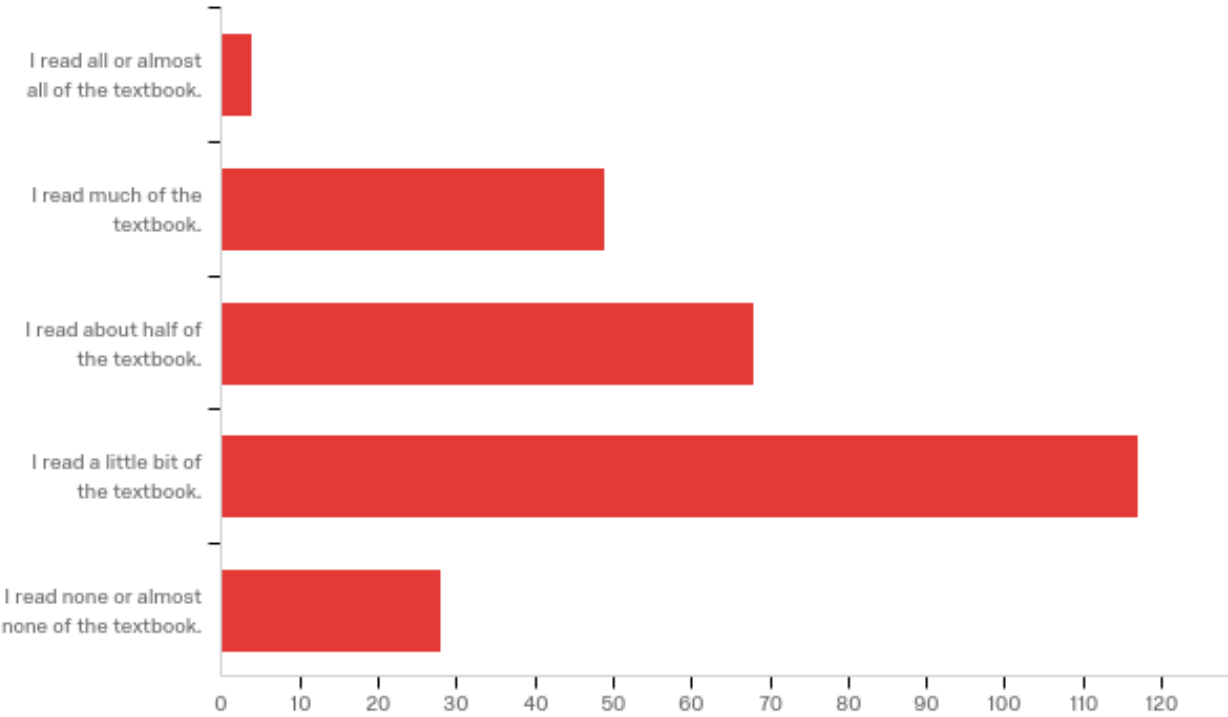

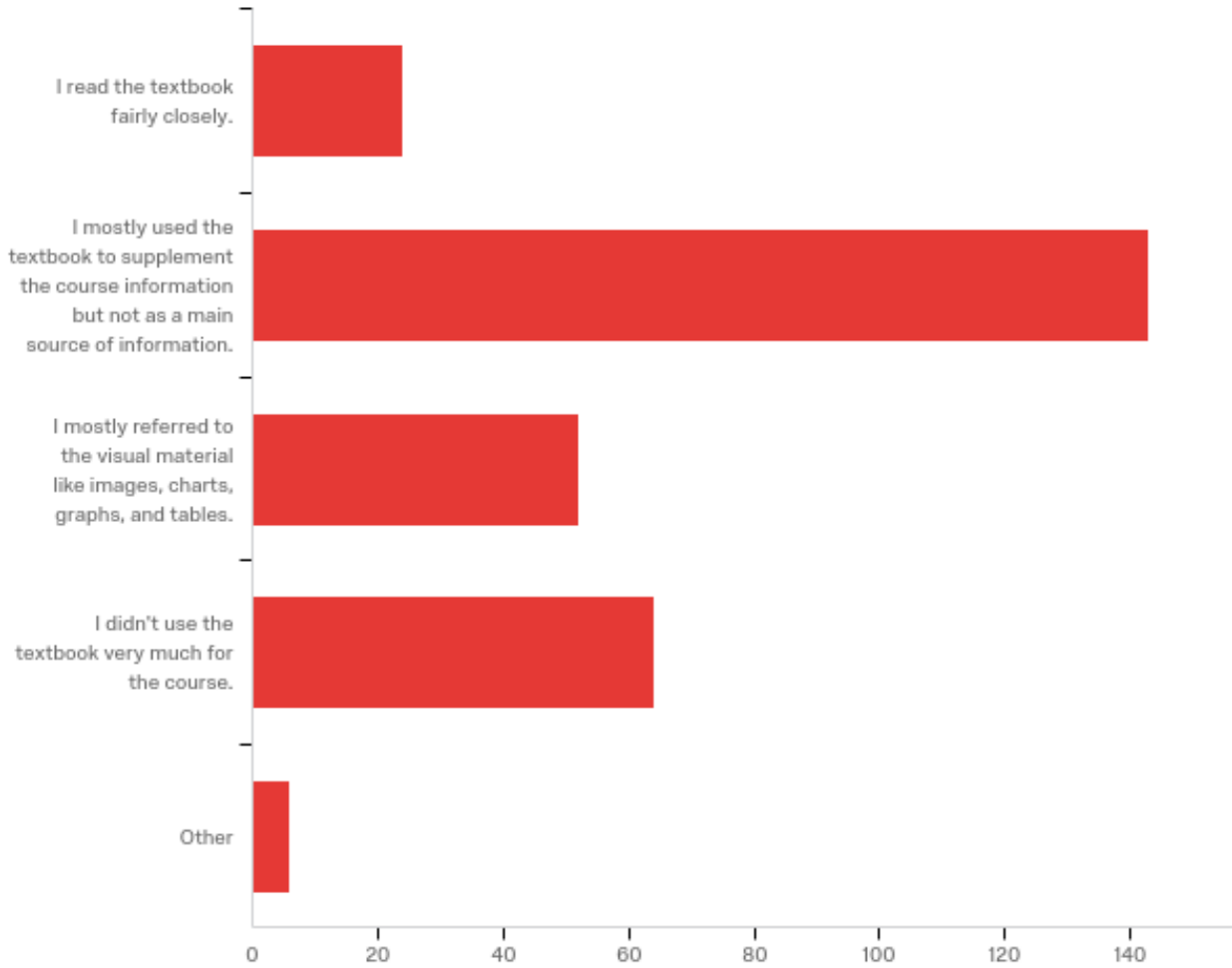

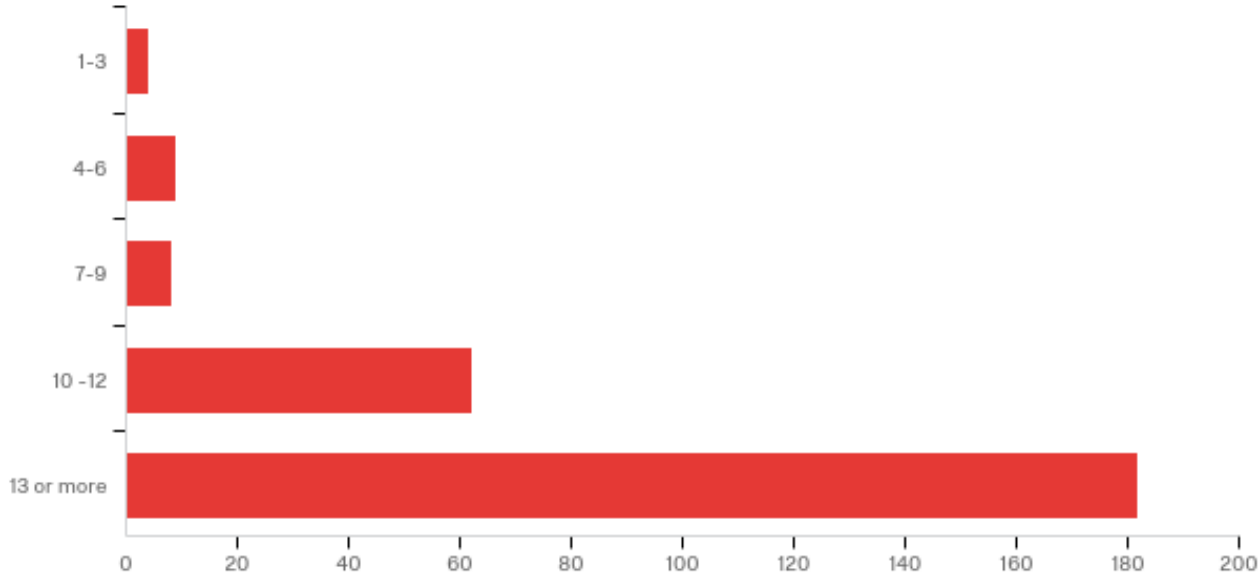

Q14 - What year are you in school?



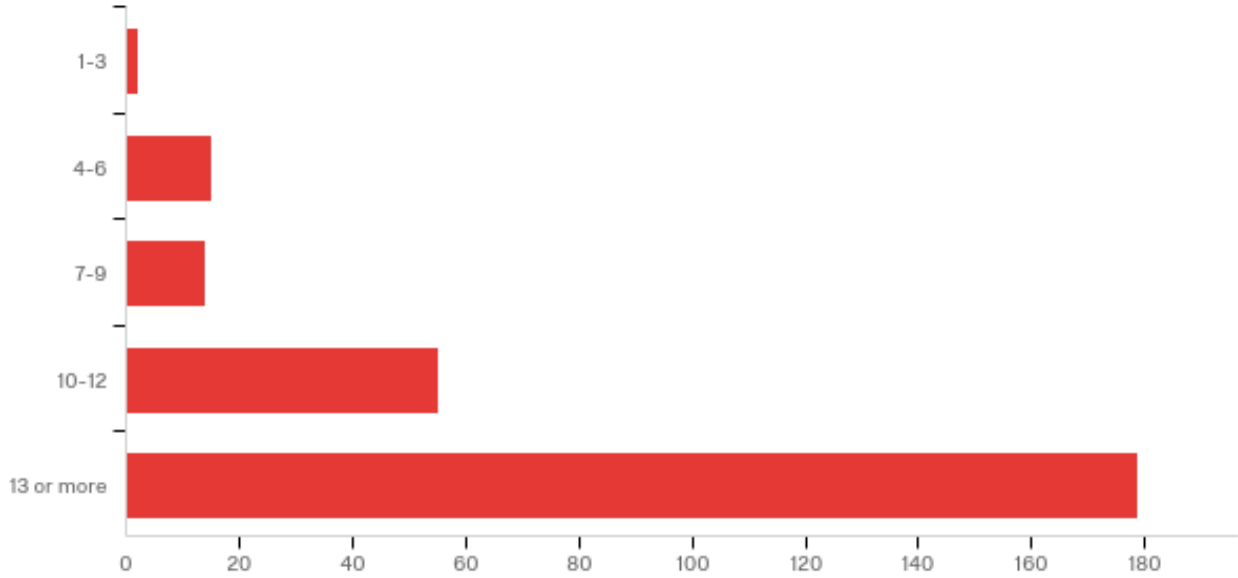

Q15 - How many credit hours are you taking this semester?



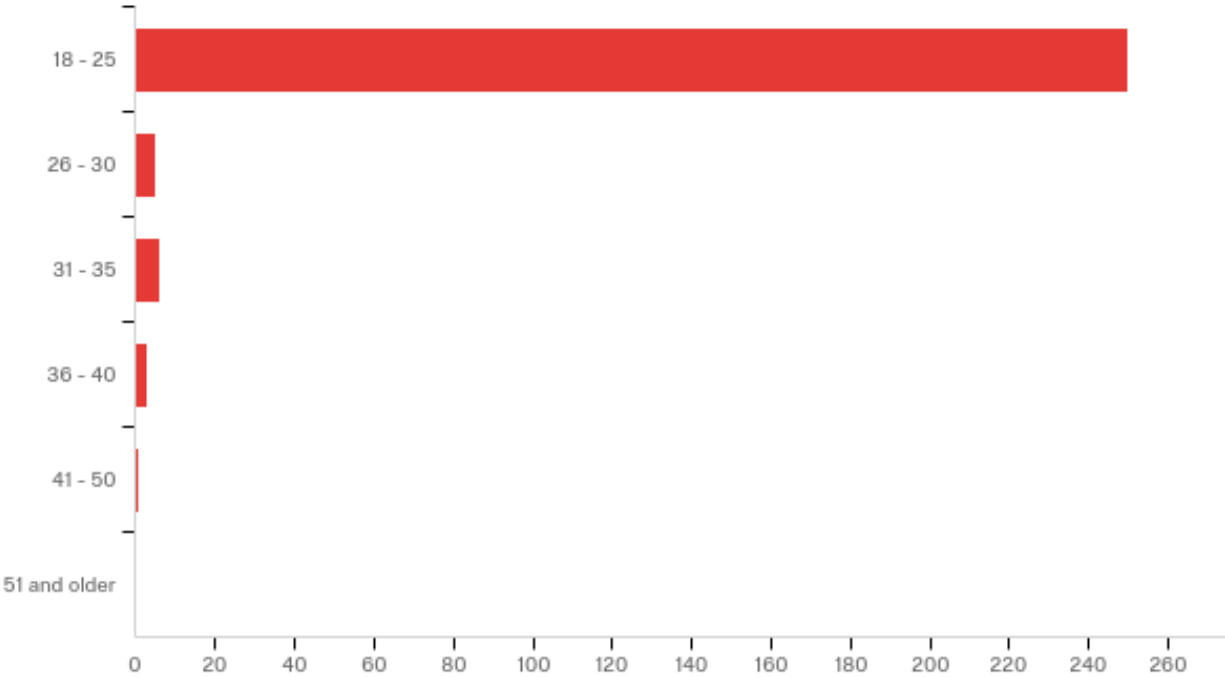

Q16 - On average, how many credit hours do you take each semester?



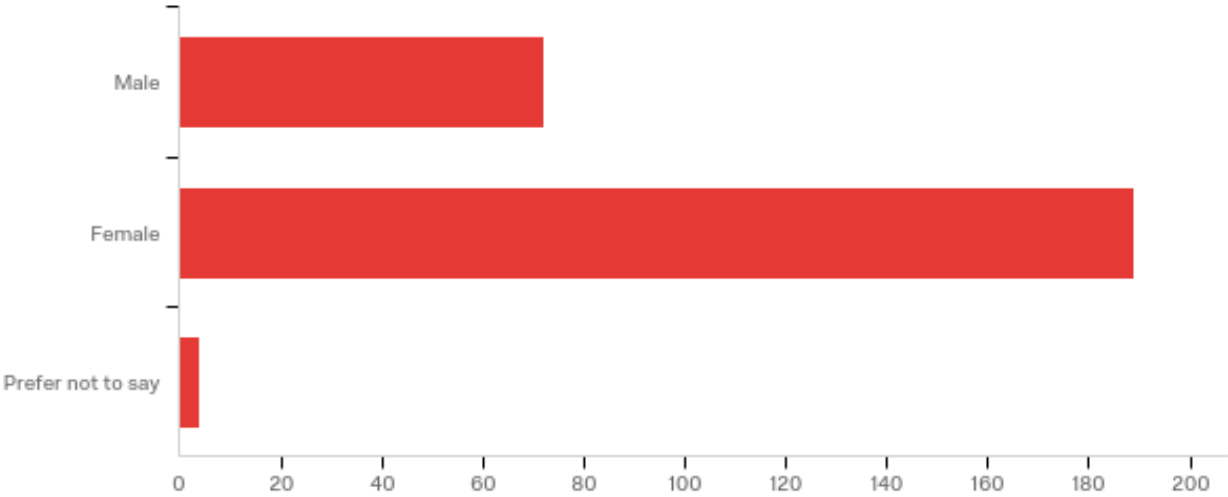

Q17 - What is your age?



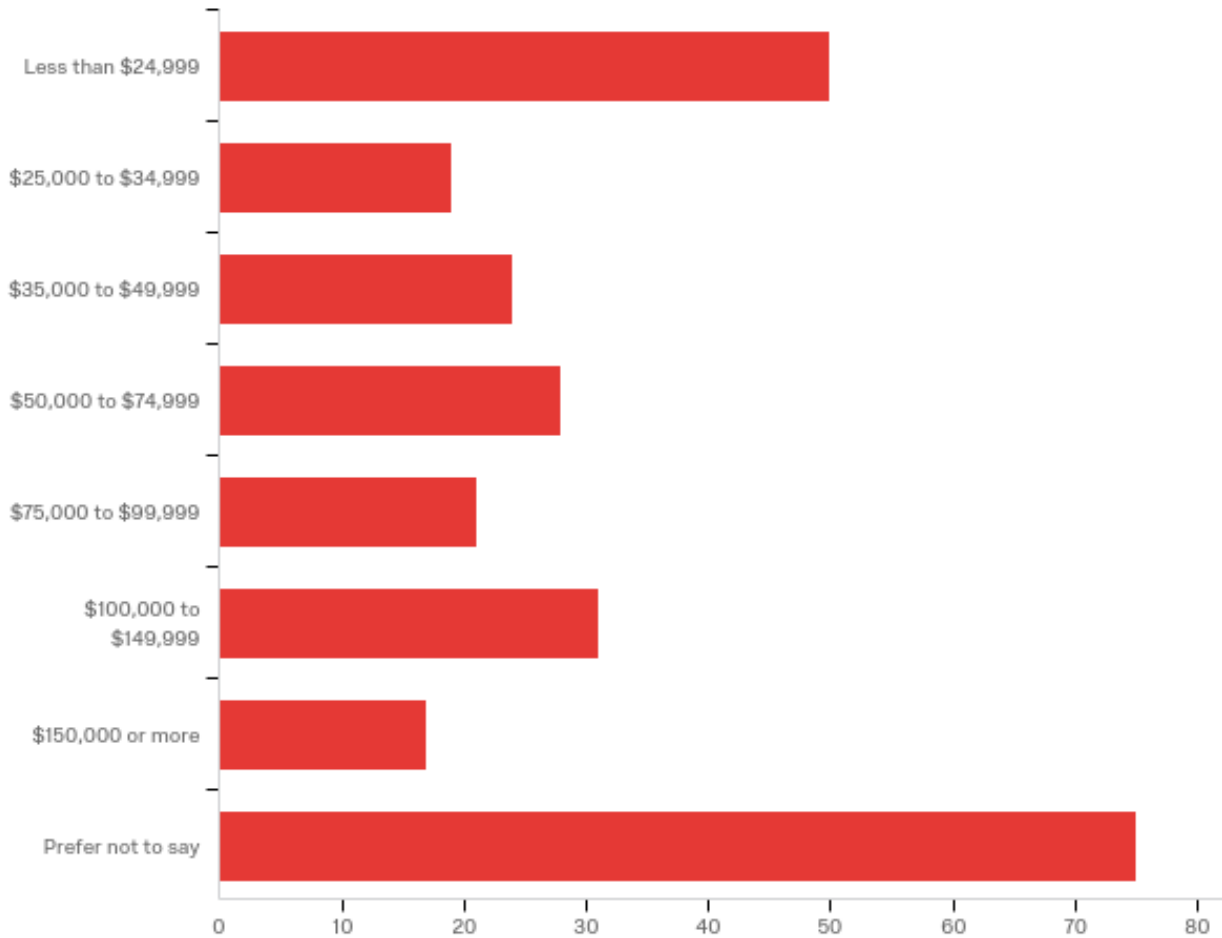

Q18 - Please indicate your gender.



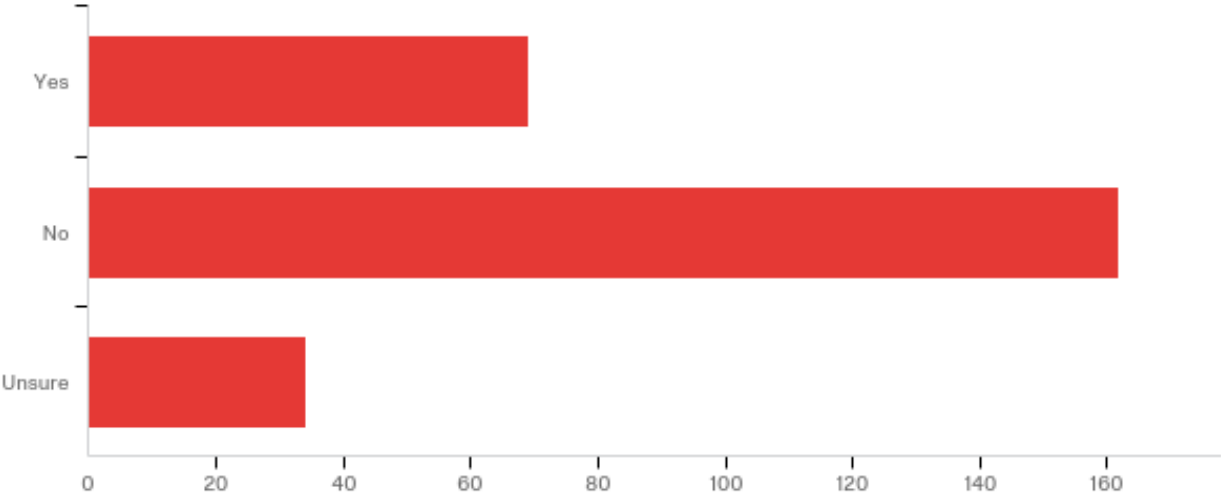

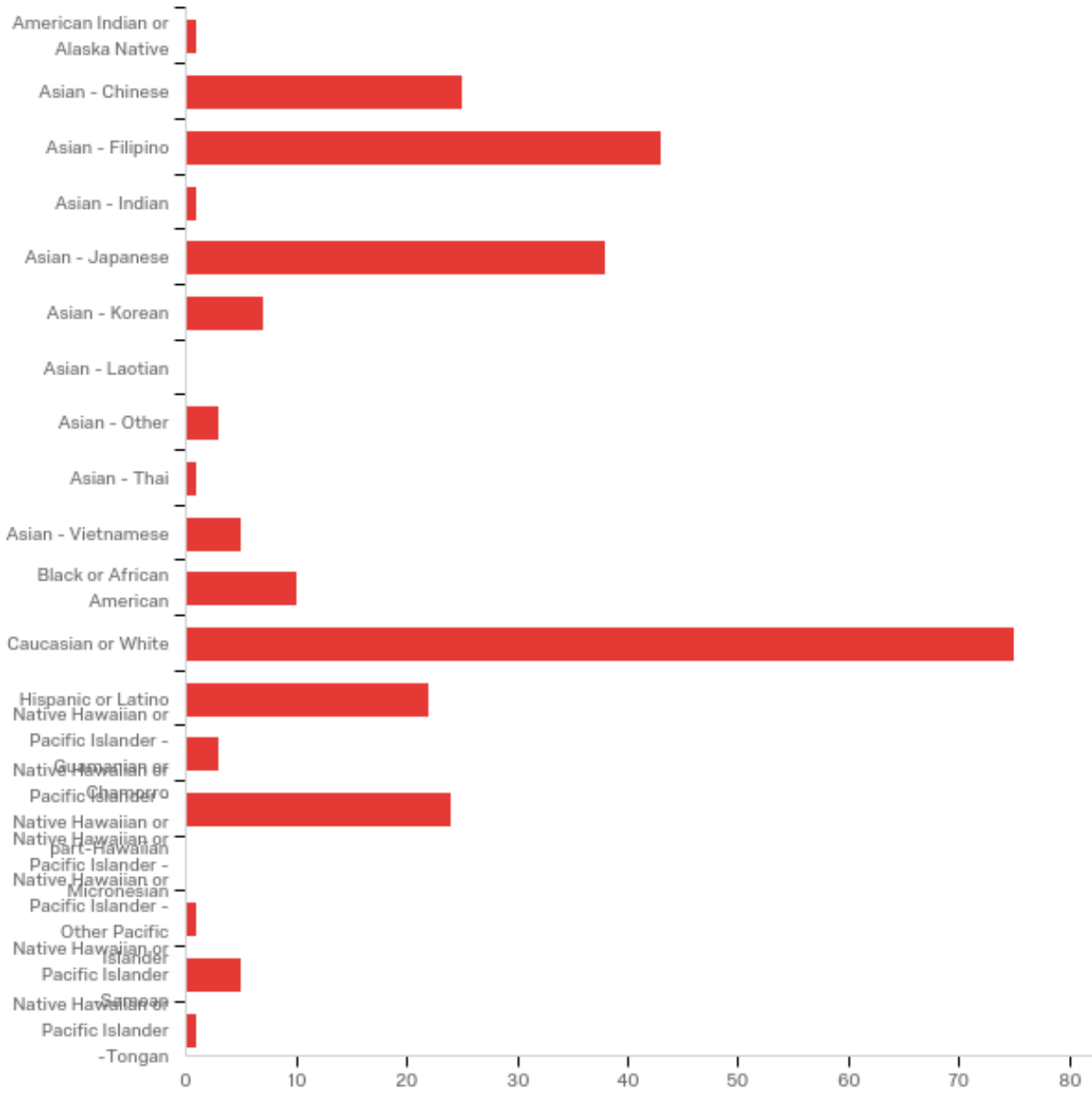

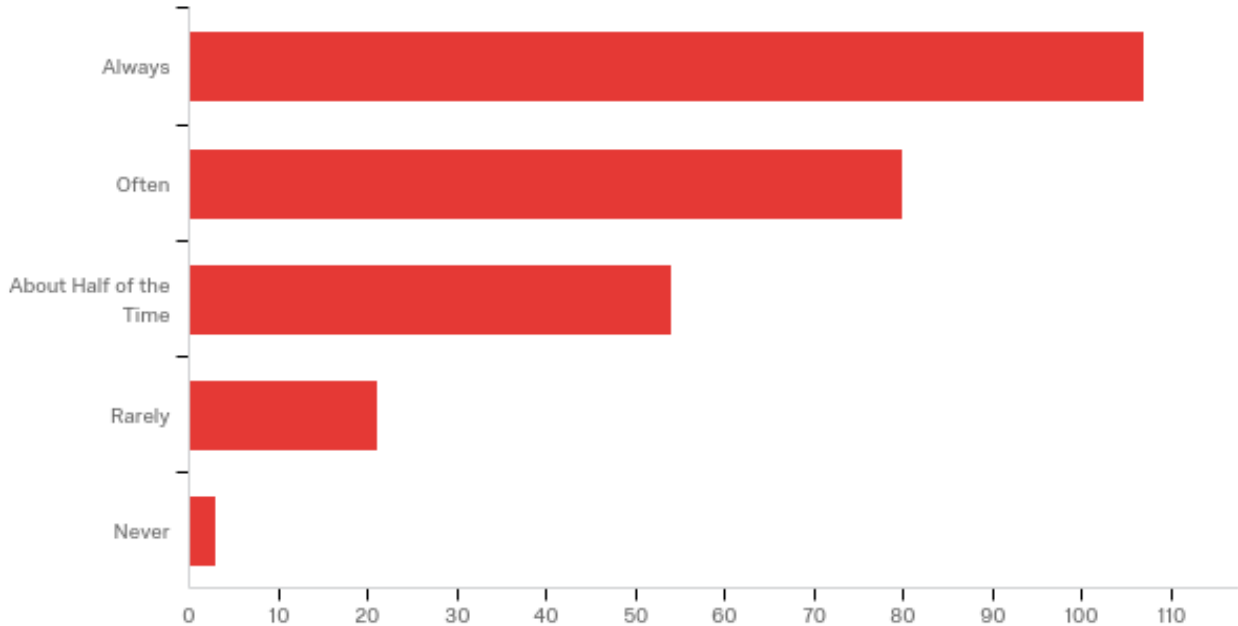
