
"KANAK INDEPENDENCE NOW":

Yann Uregei is the prominent leader of the Kanak Independence Front of New Caledonia. The Front is a coalition of five political parties: The Caledonian Union (UC), The Caledonian Socialist Party (PSC), Kanak Socialist Liberation (LKS), United Front for Kanak Liberation (FULK) and Melanesian Progressive Union (UPM). In 1979 the front won 4 out of 36 seats in the Territorial Assembly. The immediate goal of the Front is to gain recognition by the United Nations Committee on Decolonization that New Caledonia is a colony that France should grant independence to. Mr. Uregei is visiting Hawaii on his way to the United Nations to gain international support for the Kanak people.
