On Hiring (course by course) lab lds. Candidates mostly declared support for revolution. ES seems exp. sept. secured.

Other comments: need for working class perspective. Saw things wrong w/ system. Want to keep them; adults: may. have been honest + hard working; listening & smile, feel program can work ahead; good base; grad courses - willing to struggle. Adelle says she may leave ES but a coll. decision.

Dialogue w/ Ernie continue. Difficulties: no gen. line Ernie's stated: 1) Why class not rev. base in US. 2) dial. + hints. Motivation - not all aspects universal or applicable. 3) Racism: is used by EC to divide w.c. but white workers may unite w/ EC. + turn reactionary.
