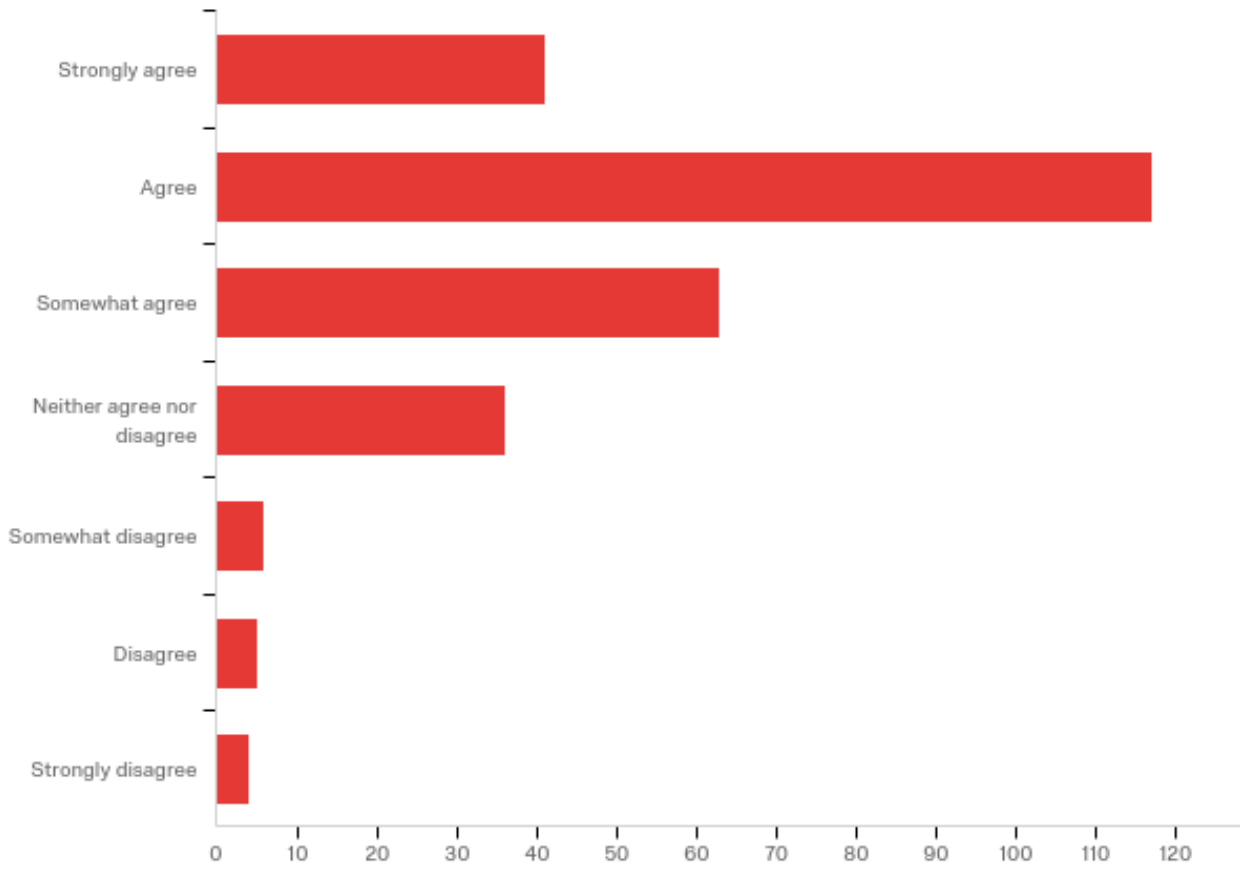

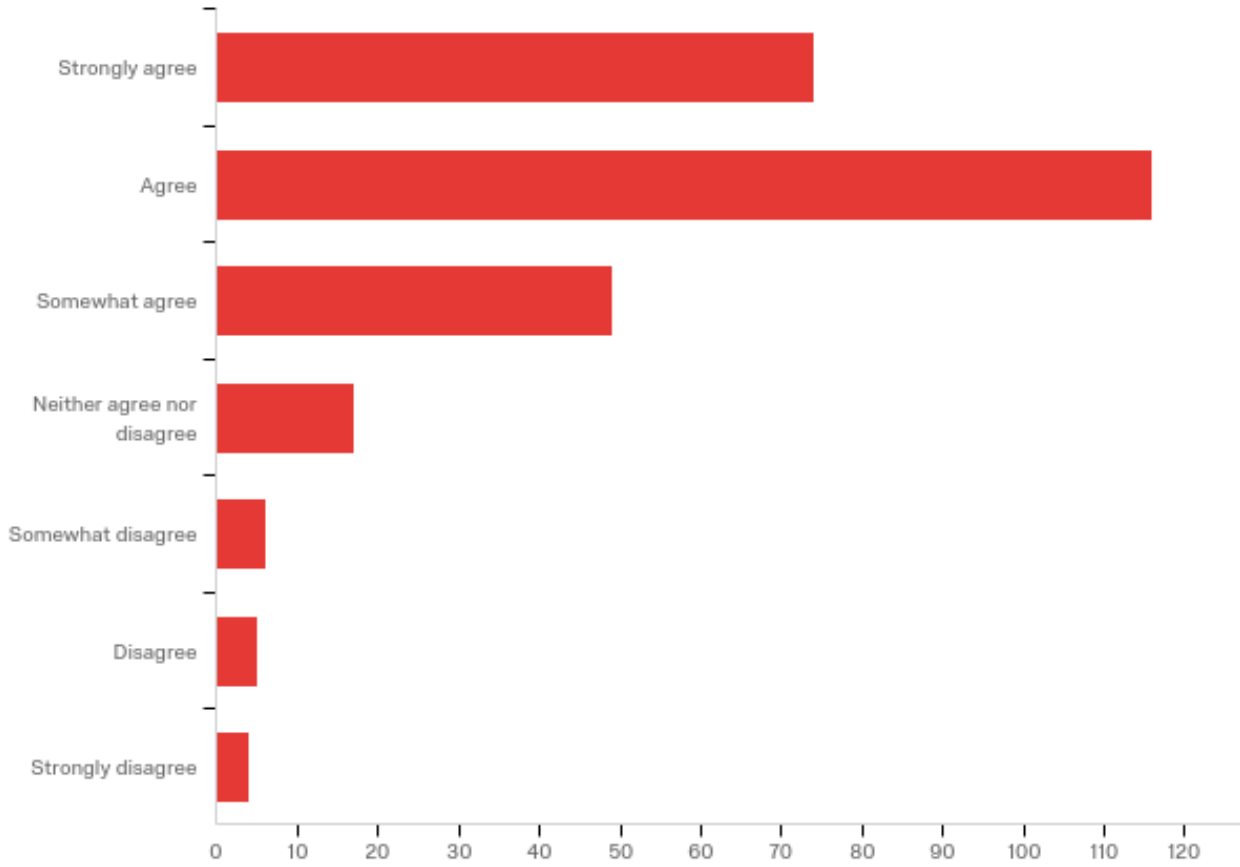

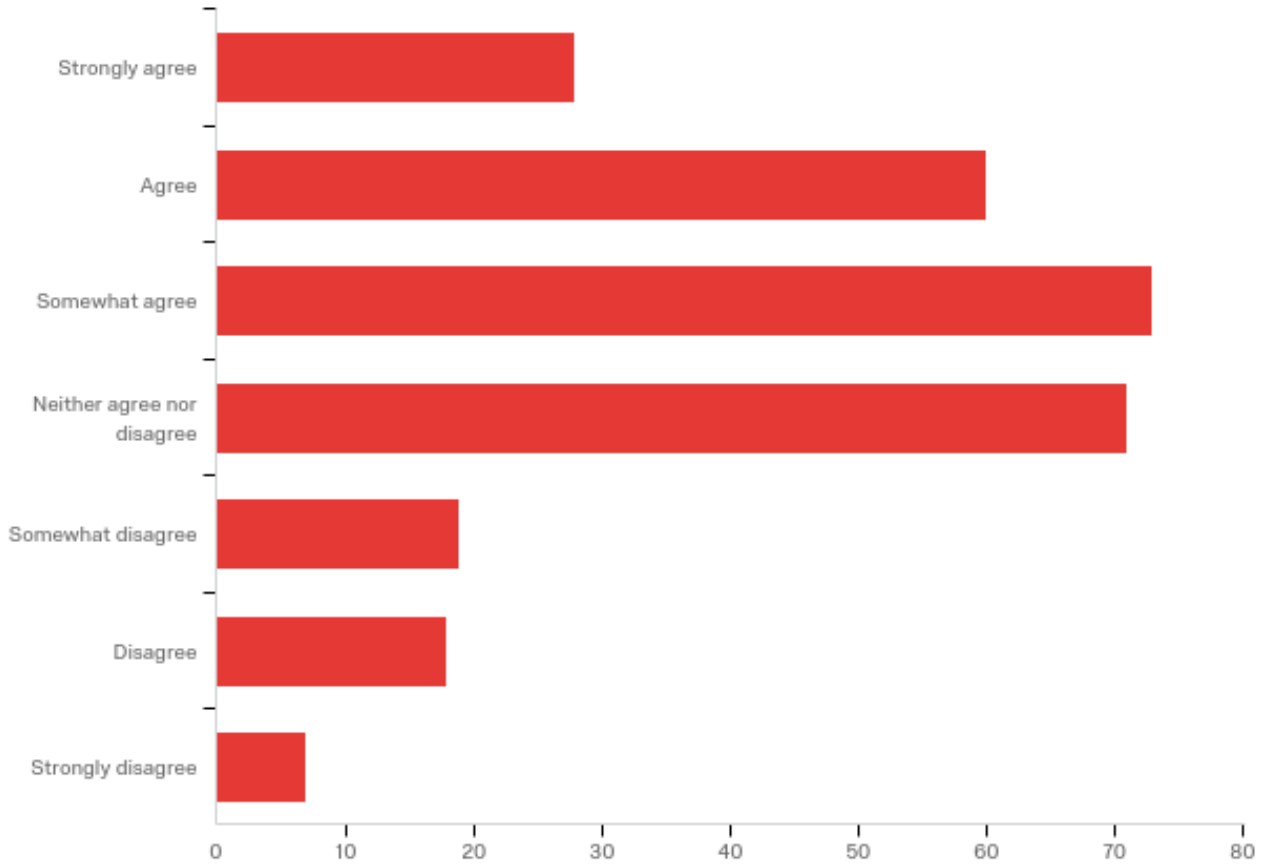

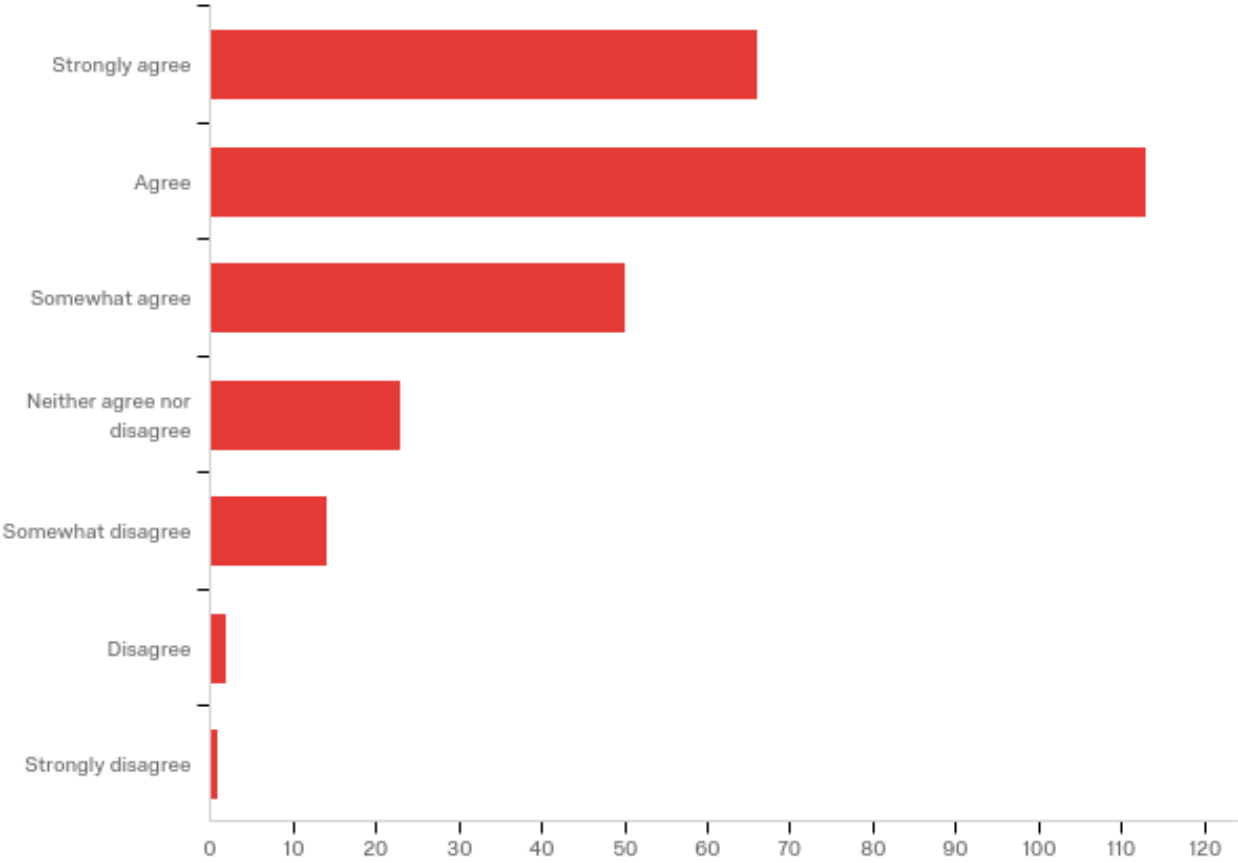

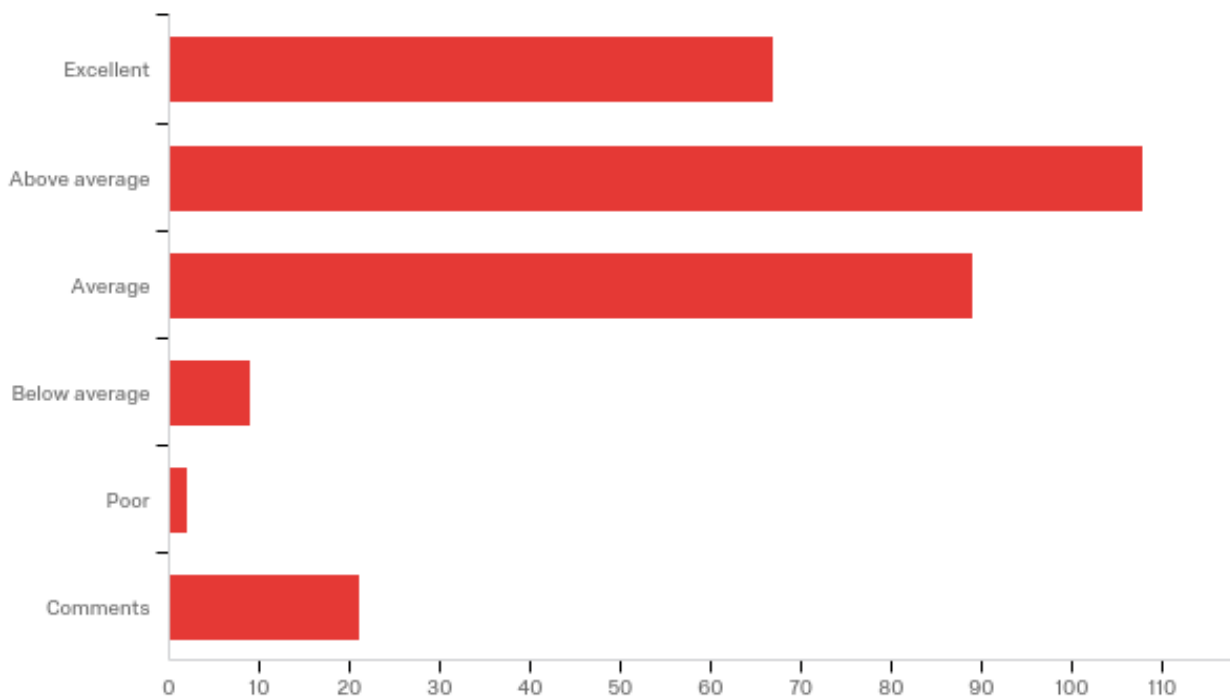

The textbook is a great resource to help me understand the topics.

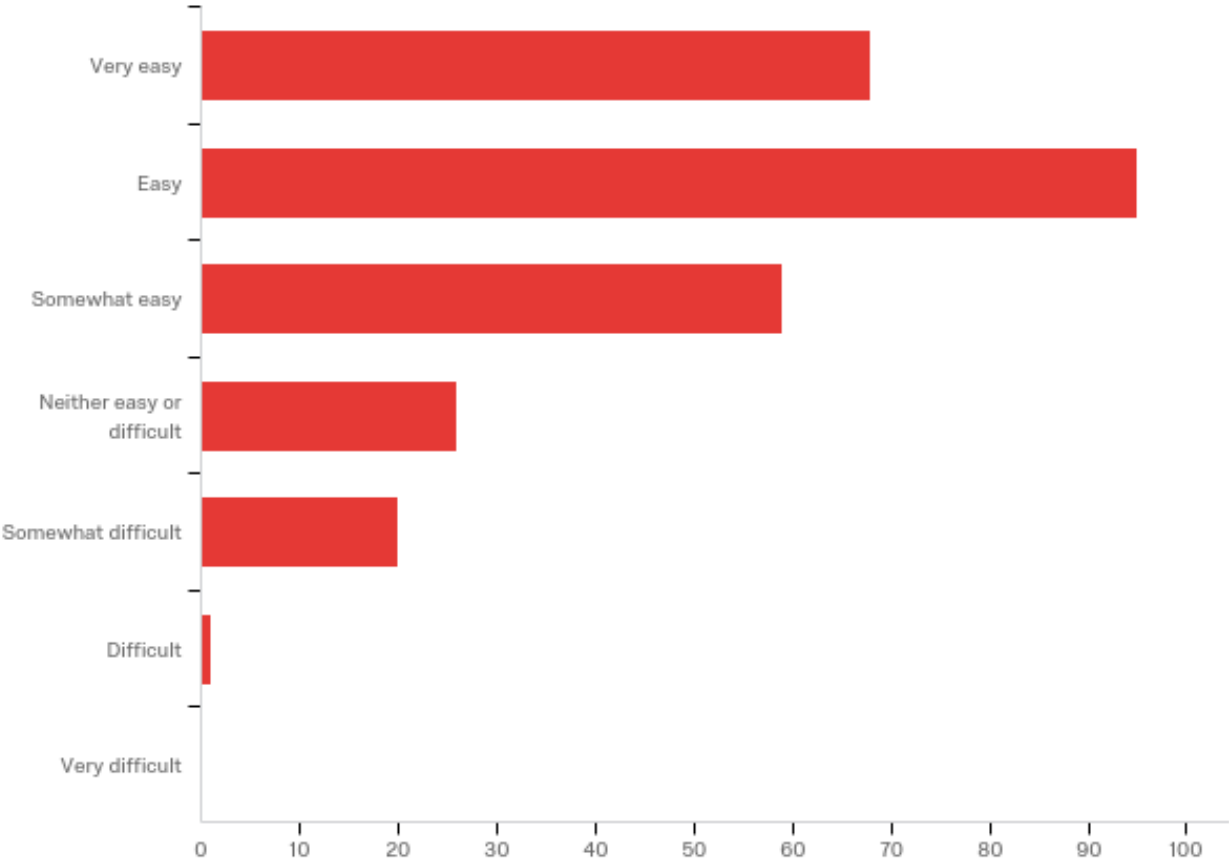

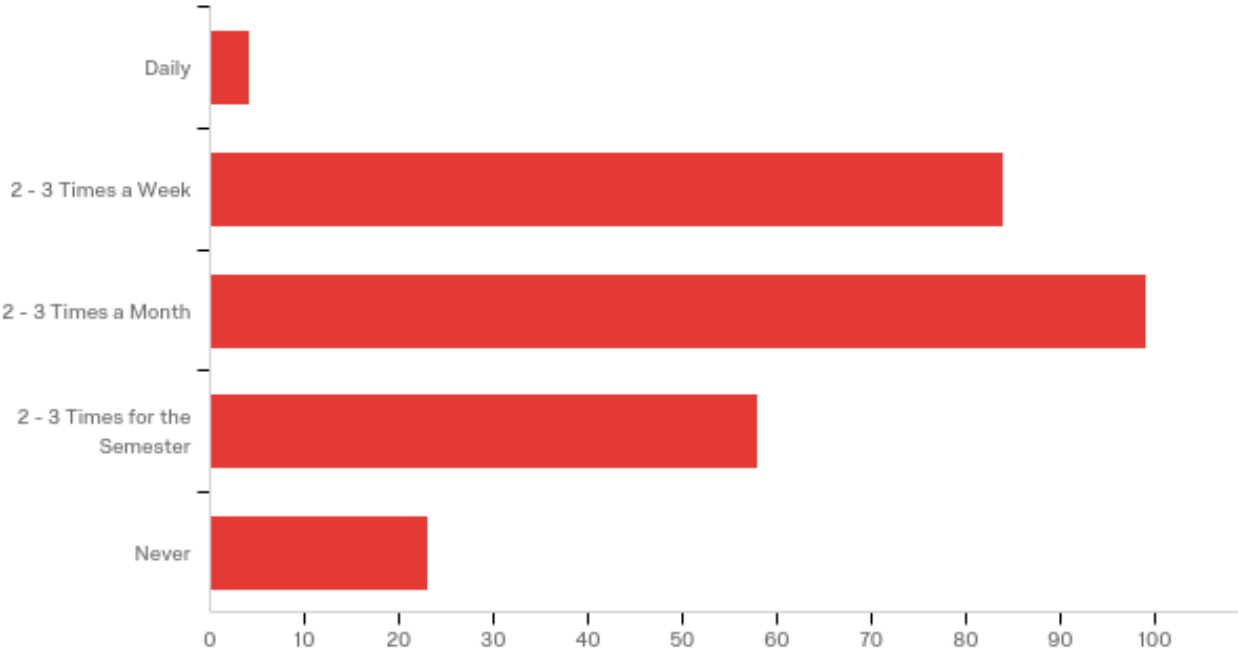

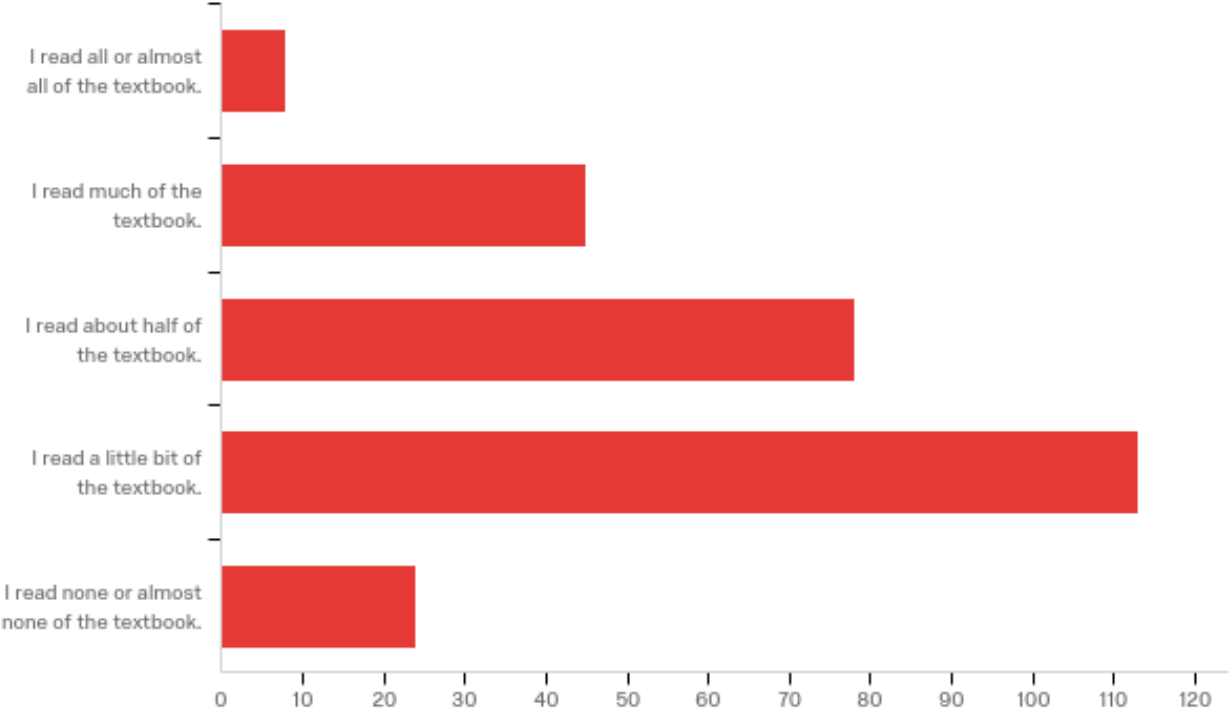

Q11 - How often did you use the textbook for this course?



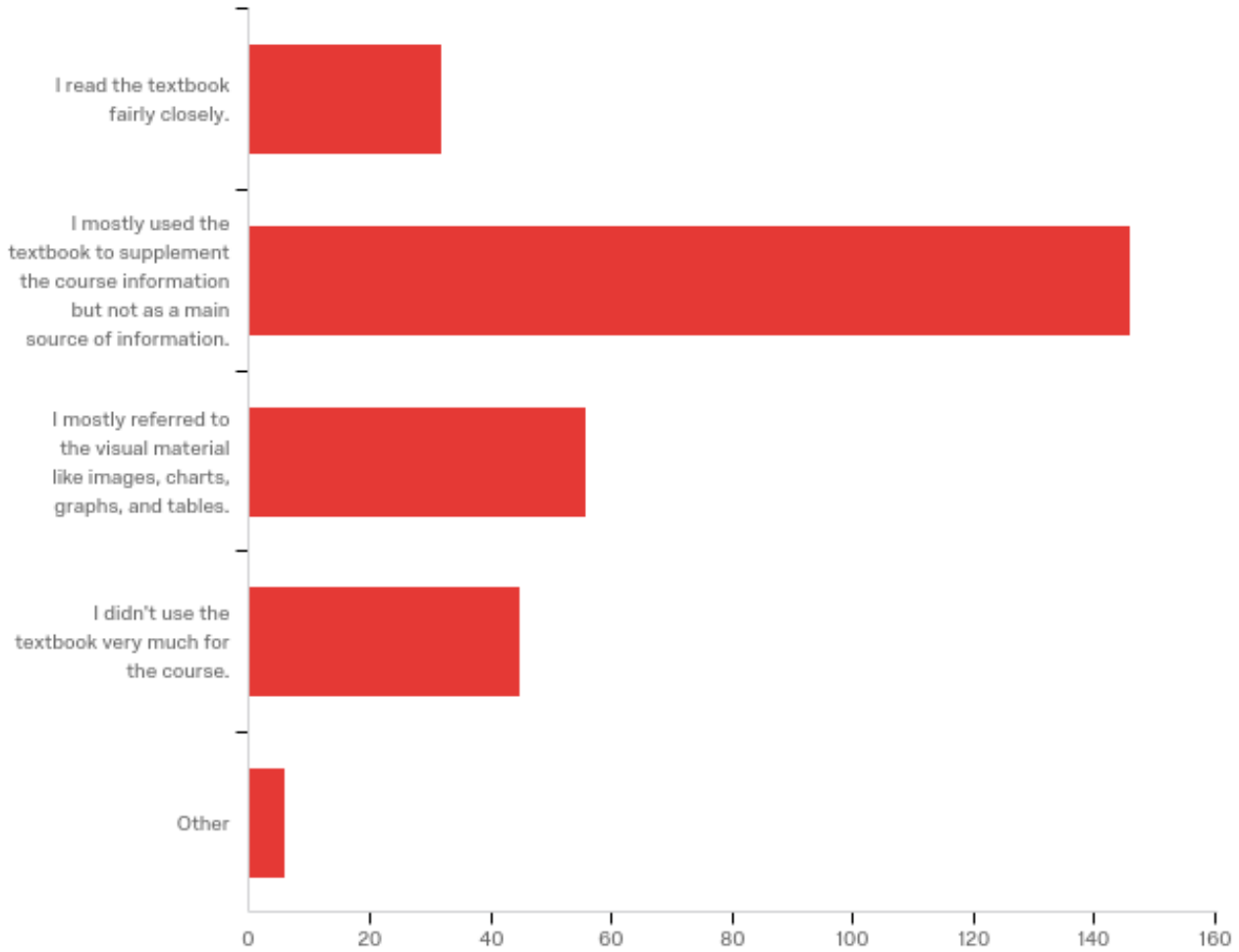

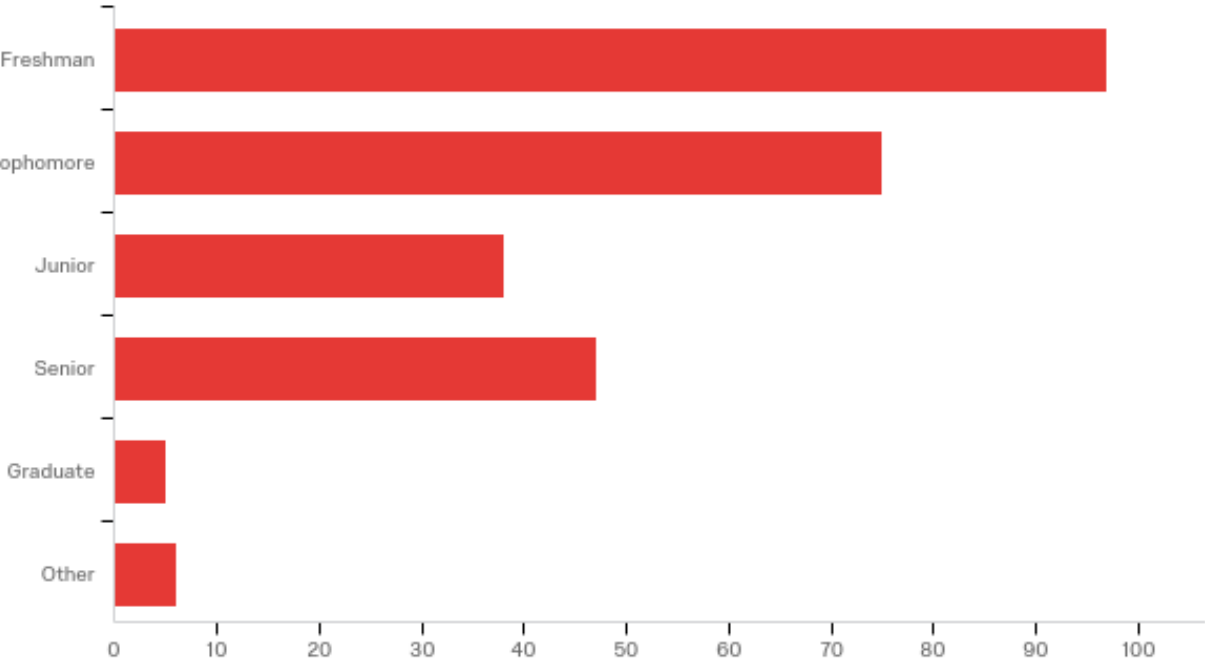

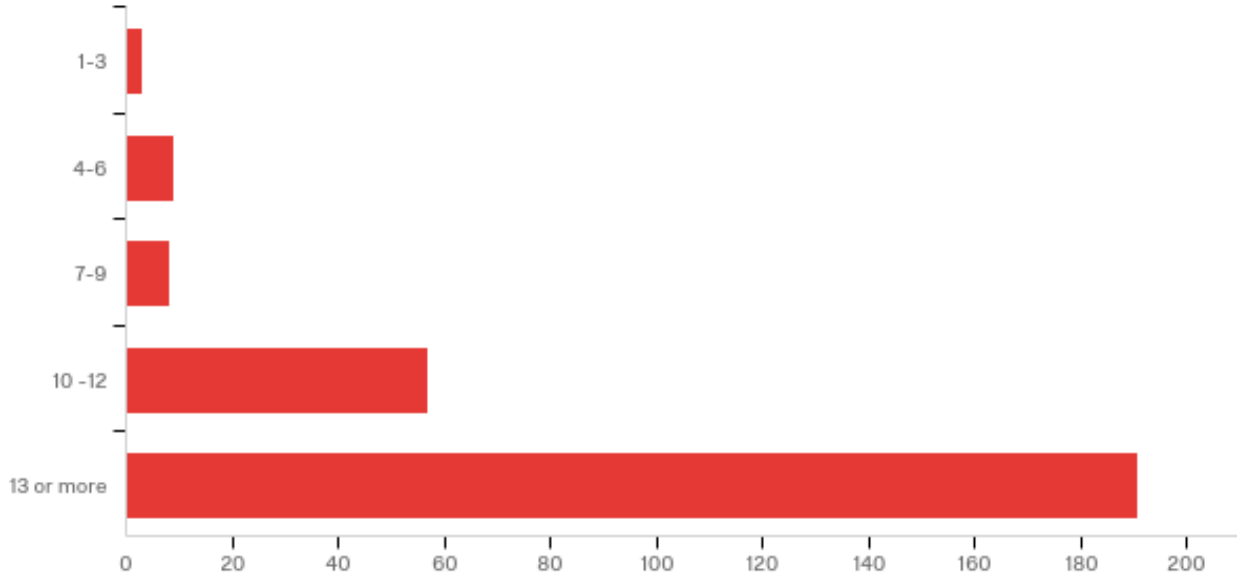

Q14 - What year are you in school?



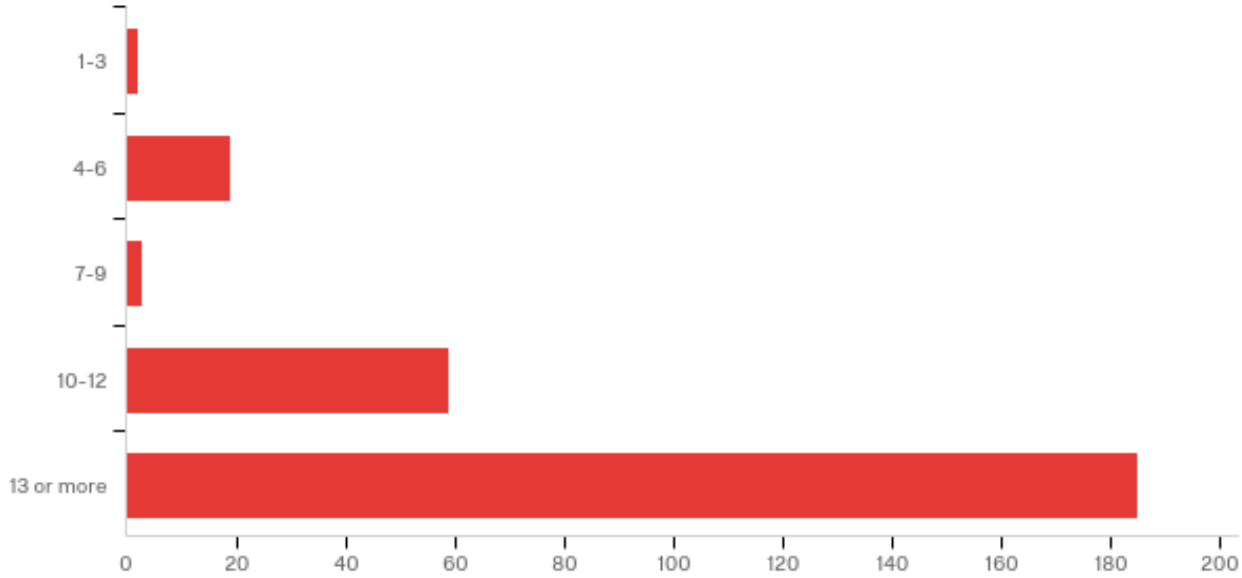

Q15 - How many credit hours are you taking this semester?



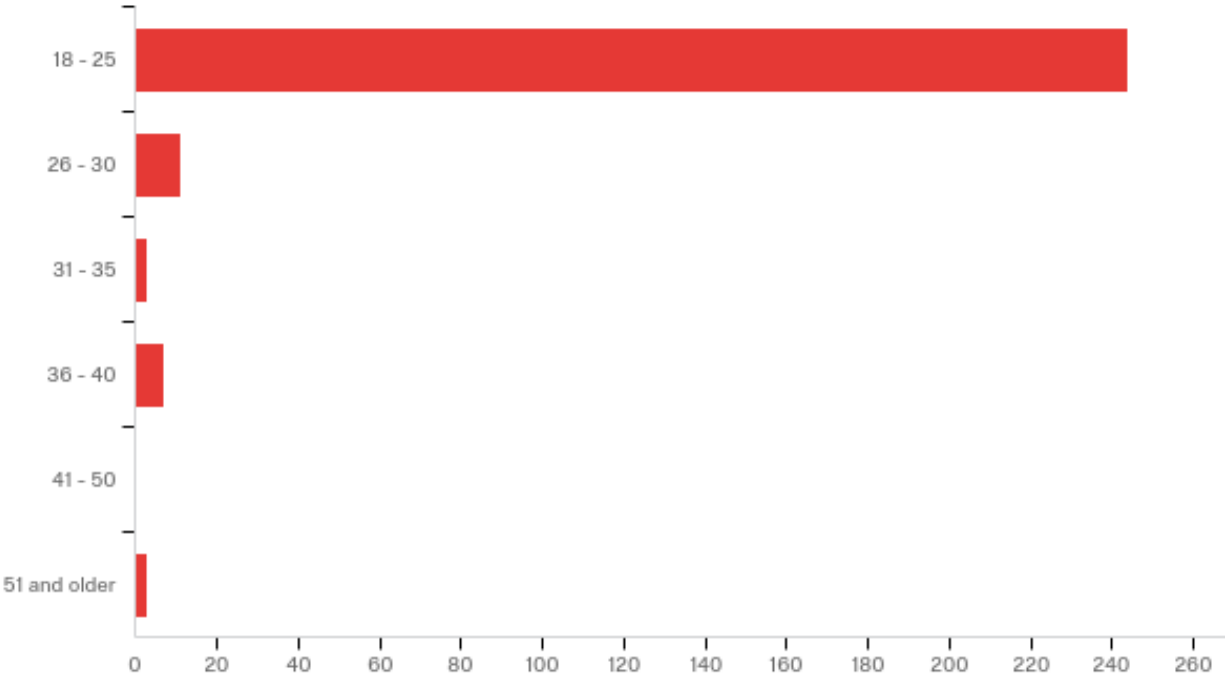

Q16 - On average, how many credit hours do you take each semester?



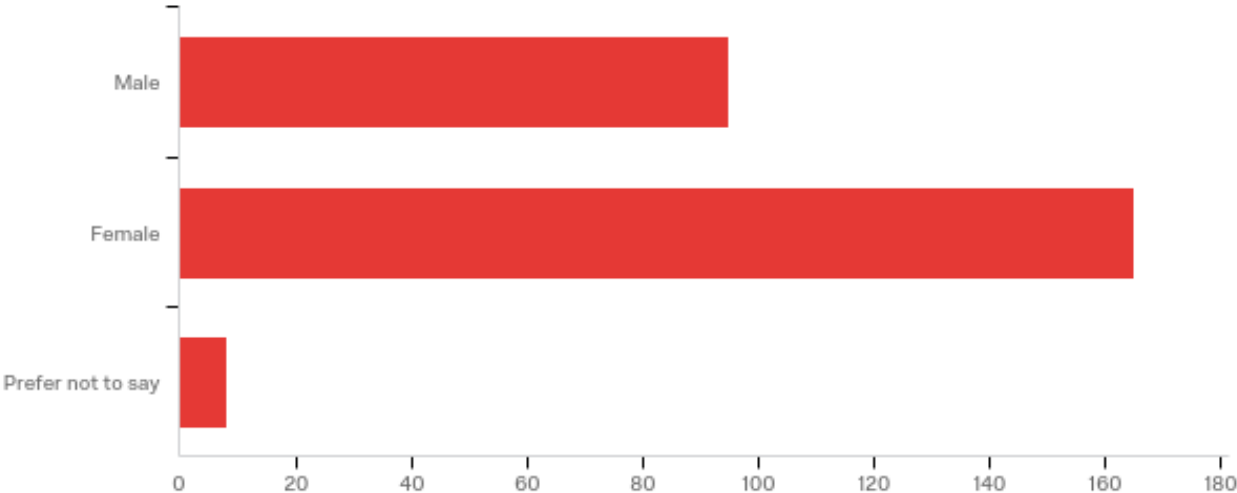

Q17 - What is your age?



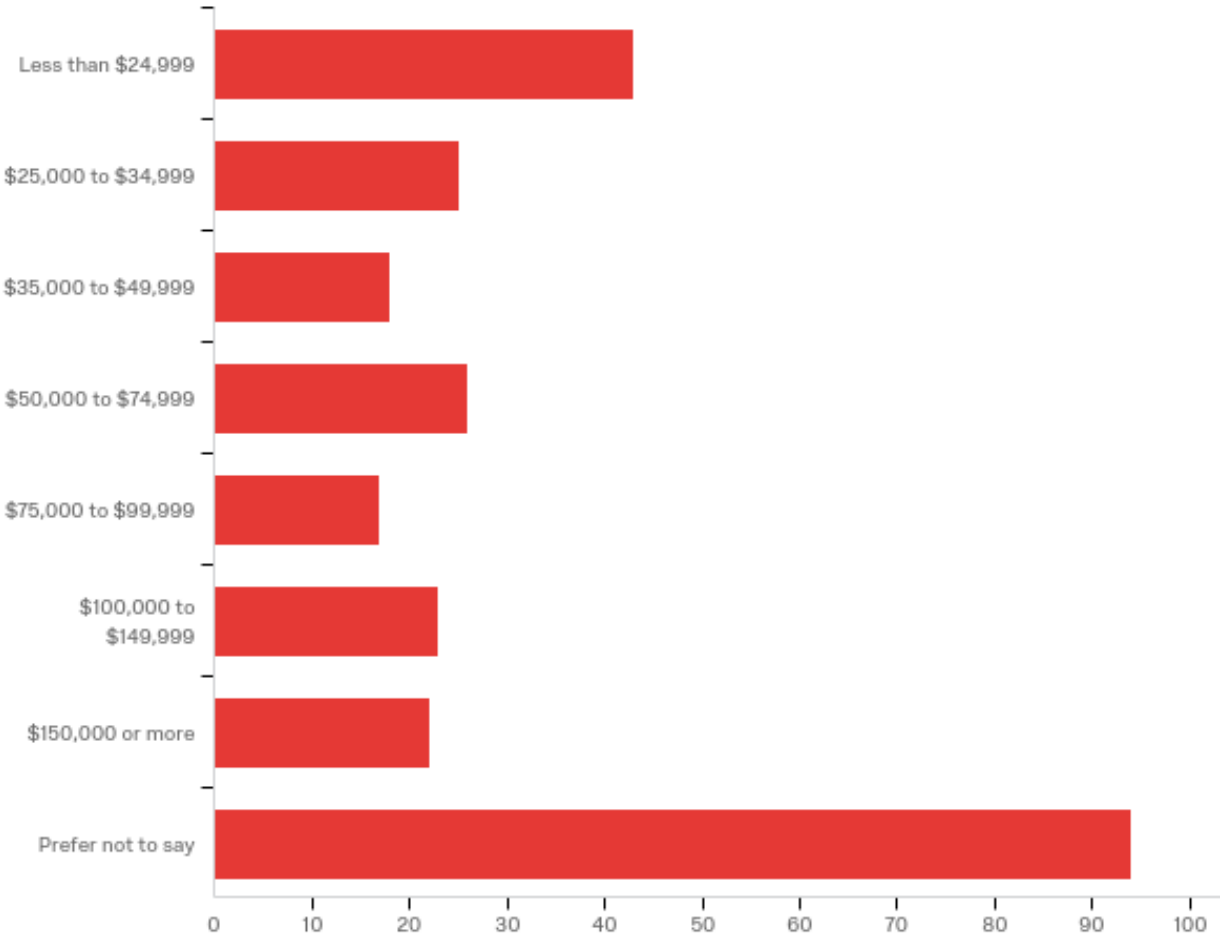

Q18 - Please indicate your gender.



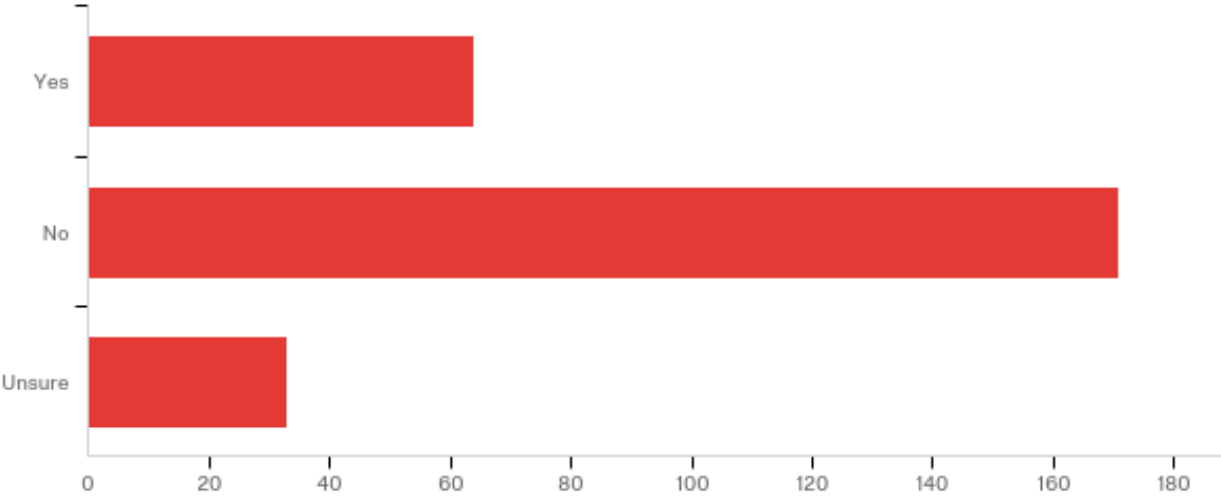

Q19 - What was your total household income before taxes during the past 12 months? (If you are financially dependent, please give your family's income.)



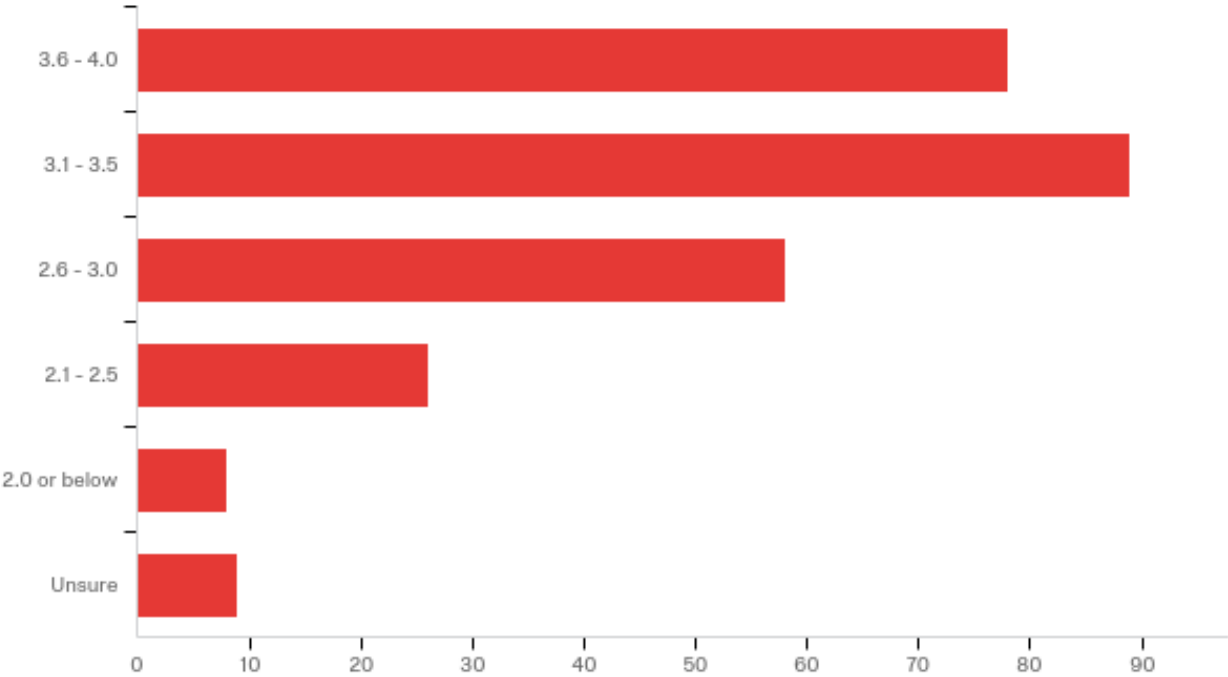

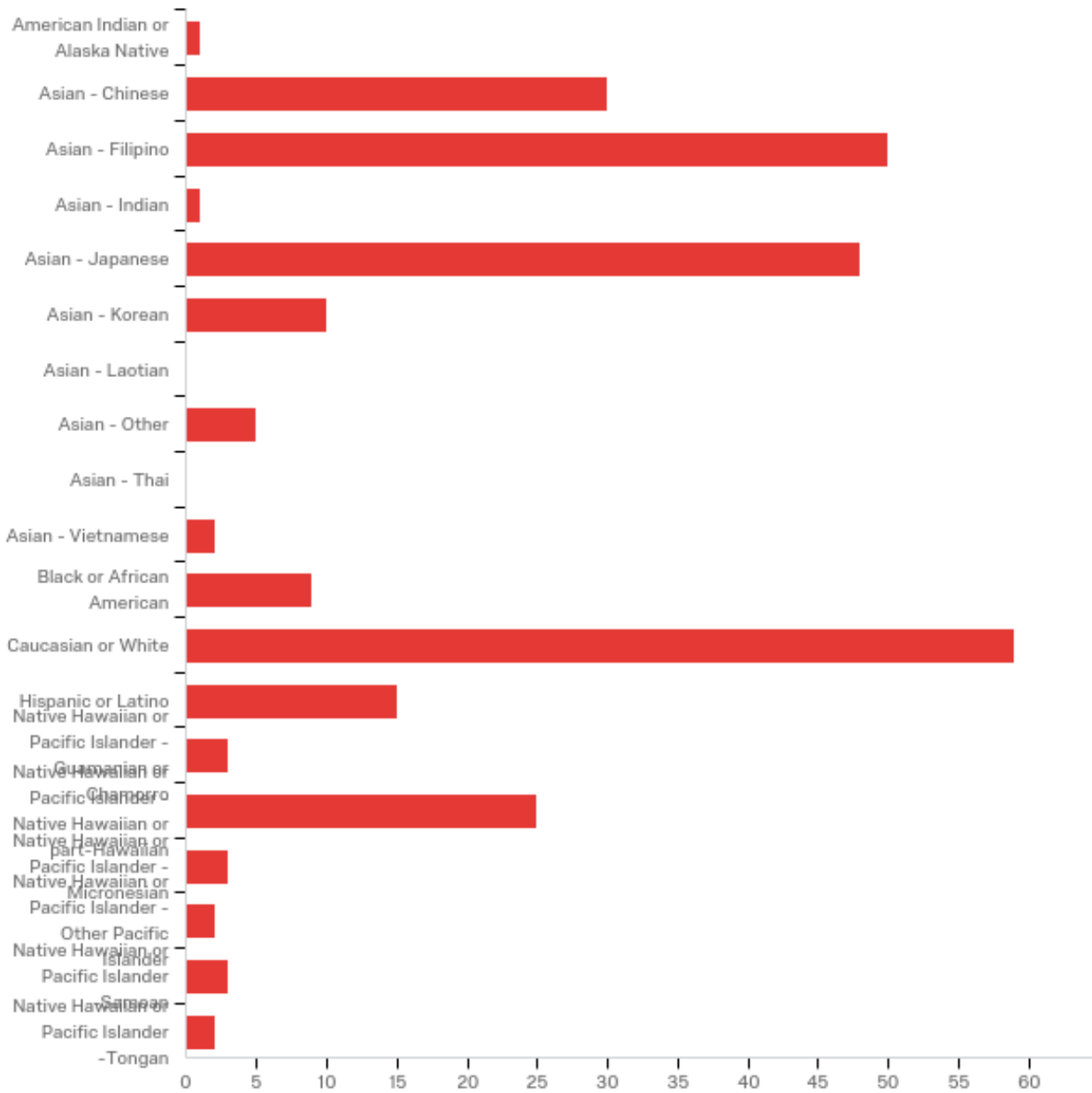

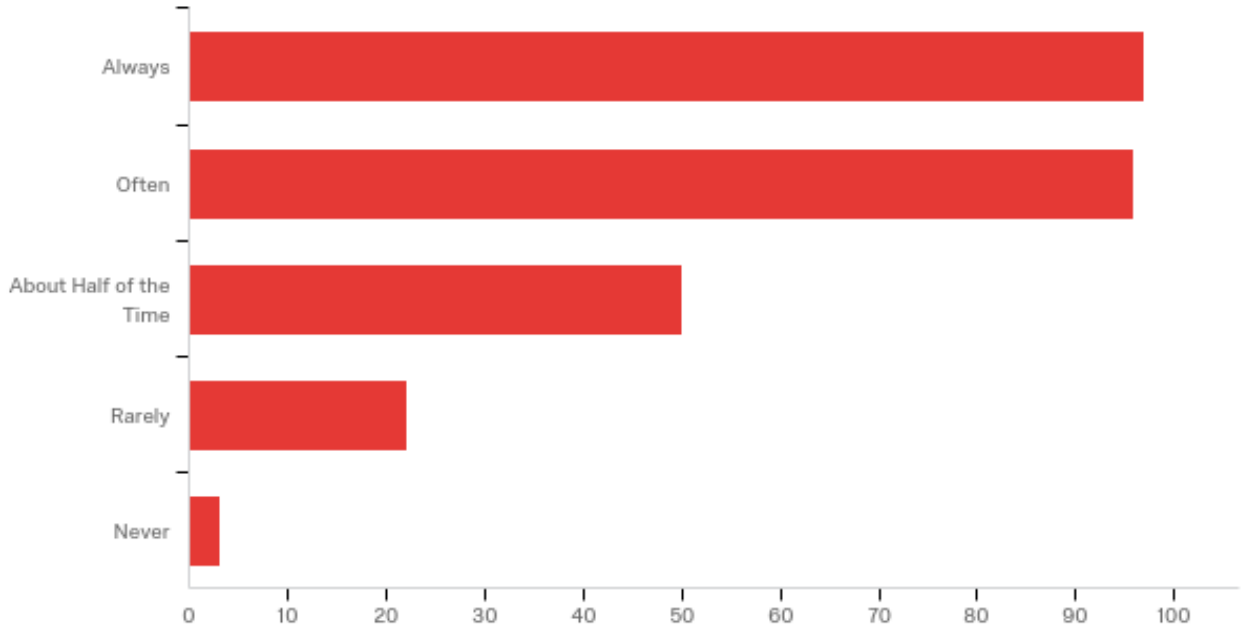
