8,9 Household Number--code the numbers(01, 02, etc.) which appear in the upper right hand corner of the personal schedule. Numbers written 1, 2, 3, etc. are coded 01, 02, 03 etc. If there is no number listed you must refer to the household schedule.

10 Household Type--code this same number for each personal schedule contained within a particular household. Determine the classification by referring to each member's answer to Relationship to Head of Household (2). Personal schedules with "visitor," "no relation," or for which there is no answer to question 2 should be ignored when determining the type of household. However, such schedules should still be coded as being the same type of household in which they appear.

1. Single person
2. Simple nuclear and broken nuclear family
Includes--couple without children
--parents with children
--one parent with children ("missing" parent can be dead, divorced, or not acknowledged even though not formally divorced)
--man with more than one wife, each of whom are with or without children
3. Simple nuclear and broken nuclear family with any relatives
As above, but includes any person present in household who is related by blood or by marriage. For example, a household with two simple nuclear families or one simple nuclear and one broken nuclear family related by blood or by marriage (a. man/wife/children plus son/wife/children; b. man/wife/children plus widowed daughter/children).
4. Unrelated persons: persons living together because of external circumstance (for example, common employer). Frequent examples: wage workers in a labour lines; teachers in a teachers house; students in school dormitory, medical assistants in a rural health clinic house, nuns in a mission house.
5. Other forms: for example, household composed of two generations that do not follow one another (grandmother/grandchild; uncle/niece; aunt/nephew)
